FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Craig Aitchison, holder of Marine Scalefish Fishery Licence No. M001 (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder'), 51 Pirie Street, Port Pirie, S.A. 5540, is exempt from Clause 60 of Schedule 1 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 2000, but only insofar as the exemption holder shall not be guilty of an offence when taking undersized Snook (*Sphyraena novaehollandiae*) using a fish net in coastal waters of the State (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1, from the date of gazettal of this notice until 31 December 2002, unless varied or revoked earlier.

SCHEDULE 1

1. The exemption holder may take snook (*Sphyraena novaehollandiae*) not less than 30 cm.

2. All fish taken pursuant to this notice that are not less than 42 cm may be used for trade or business.

3. The exemption holder must provide all snook (*Sphyraena novaehollandiae*) not less than 30 cm and less than 42 cm taken pursuant to this notice, to South Australian Research and Development Institute Aquatic Sciences (SARDI Aquatic Sciences), as directed by Dr Keith Jones of SARDI Aquatic Sciences, and must not be sold.

4. Whilst conducting the exempted activity, the exemption holder must only conduct the exempted activity using devices that are endorsed on Marine Scalefish Fishery Licence No. M001.

5. Whilst conducting the exempted activity, the exemption holder must only use a boat that is endorsed on Marine Scalefish Fishery Licence No. M001.

6. The exemption holder may only undertake the exempted activity on one allocated sampling day per fortnight, as specified by Dr Keith Jones of SARDI Aquatic Sciences, for the duration of the snook research project. The exemption holder must only fish on his allocated sampling day or as otherwise directed by Dr Keith Jones of SARDI Aquatic Sciences.

7. The exemption holder must immediately and accurately record the information required in the snook measuring form and snook research log supplied by SARDI Aquatic Sciences. The completed documents must be supplied to SARDI Aquatic Sciences within 14 days of the completion of each calendar month.

8. PIRSA Fisheries retains the right for a departmental officer or an employee of SARDI Aquatic Sciences to observe the exempted activity at any time.

9. The exemption holder must notify the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 at least 24 hours prior to conducting the exempted activity and provide the following information:

- the intended launch and retrieval time and location;
- the intended fishing area; and
- details of the boat to be used.

10. Whilst engaged in the exempted activity the exemption holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice and produce a copy of the notice if required by a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer.

11. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under the Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Patrick J. Martin, holder of Marine Scalefish Fishery Licence No. M181 (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder'), 31 Augusta Terrace, Port Augusta, S.A. 5700, is exempt from Clause 60 of Schedule 1 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 2000, but only insofar as the exemption holder shall not be guilty of an offence when taking undersized Snook (*Sphyraena novaehollandiae*) using a fish net in coastal waters of the State (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1, from the date of gazettal of this notice until 31 December 2002, unless varied or revoked earlier.

SCHEDULE 1

1. The exemption holder may take snook (*Sphyraena novaehollandiae*) not less than 30 cm.

2. All fish taken pursuant to this notice that are not less than 42 cm may be used for trade or business.

3. The exemption holder must provide all snook (*Sphyraena novaehollandiae*) not less than 30 cm and less than 42 cm taken pursuant to this notice, to South Australian Research and Development Institute Aquatic Sciences (SARDI Aquatic Sciences), as directed by Dr Keith Jones of SARDI Aquatic Sciences, and must not be sold.

4. Whilst conducting the exempted activity, the exemption holder must only conduct the exempted activity using devices that are endorsed on Marine Scalefish Fishery Licence No. M181.

5. Whilst conducting the exempted activity, the exemption holder must only use a boat that is endorsed on Marine Scalefish Fishery Licence No. M181.

6. The exemption holder may only undertake the exempted activity on one allocated sampling day per fortnight, as specified by Dr Keith Jones of SARDI Aquatic Sciences, for the duration of the snook research project. The exemption holder must only fish on his allocated sampling day or as otherwise directed by Dr Keith Jones of SARDI Aquatic Sciences.

7. The exemption holder must immediately and accurately record the information required in the snook measuring form and snook research log supplied by SARDI Aquatic Sciences. The completed documents must be supplied to SARDI Aquatic Sciences within 14 days of the completion of each calendar month.

8. PIRSA Fisheries retains the right for a departmental officer or an employee of SARDI Aquatic Sciences to observe the exempted activity at any time.

9. The exemption holder must notify the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 at least 24 hours prior to conducting the exempted activity and provide the following information:

- the intended launch and retrieval time and location;
- the intended fishing area; and
- details of the boat to be used.

10. Whilst engaged in the exempted activity the exemption holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice and produce a copy of the notice if required by a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer.

11. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under the Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
