Variation to Existing Approval of Collection Depot

I, ANDREA KAYE WOODS, Delegate of the Environment Protection Authority ('the Authority'), pursuant to Section 69 of the Environment Protection Act 1993 (SA) ('the Act') hereby:

Variation to Existing Approval of Collection Depot

Vary the approval of the collection depot, listed at Schedule 1 of this Notice, that was granted under the Act prior to the date of this Notice and impose the conditions of this approval to be as follows:

Approval of Collection Depot

The collection depot identified by reference to the following matters is approved:
