## **Administrative Arrangements (Constitution of Ministers as Bodies Corporate) Proclamation 2014**

under section 7 of the *Administrative Arrangements Act 1994*

### **1—Short title**

This proclamation may be cited as the *Administrative Arrangements (Constitution of Ministers as Bodies Corporate) Proclamation 2014*.

### **2—Commencement**

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

### **3—Dissolution of certain bodies corporate**

The bodies corporate referred to in Schedule 1 are dissolved.

### **4—Constitution of certain Ministers as bodies corporate**

The Ministers referred to in Schedule 2 are constituted as bodies corporate.

### **5—Vesting of certain assets, rights and liabilities**

- (1) The assets, rights and liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister Assisting the Minister for the Arts are vested in and attached to the Minister for the Arts.
- (2) The assets, rights and liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Health and Ageing are vested in and attached to the Minister for Ageing and the Minister for Health according to the distribution of Ministerial responsibilities and functions between the relevant Ministers so that assets, rights and liabilities appropriate to particular responsibilities or functions vest in, or attach to, the appropriate body corporate.
- (3) The assets, rights and liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for State/Local Government Relations are vested in and attached to the Minister for Local Government.
- (4) The assets, rights and liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Transport Services are vested in and attached to the Minister for Transport and Infrastructure.

## **Administrative Arrangements (References to Ministers) Proclamation 2014**

under section 8 of the *Administrative Arrangements Act 1994*

### **1—Short title**

This proclamation may be cited as the *Administrative Arrangements (References to Ministers) Proclamation 2014*.

### **2—Commencement**

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

### **3—Interpretative provision**

- (1) A reference to the Minister Assisting the Minister for the Arts in an Act, a statutory instrument under an Act or any other kind of instrument, or a contract, agreement or other document will have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister for the Arts.
- (2) A reference to the Minister for Health and Ageing in an Act or a statutory instrument under an Act will, if the Act was, on the day immediately before the effective date, committed to the administration of that Minister, have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister to whom the administration of the Act is for the time being committed.
- (3) A reference to the Minister for Health and Ageing in a statutory instrument or any other kind of instrument, or a contract, agreement or other document, made or entered into before the effective date (other than a reference to which subclause (2) is applicable) will have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister for Ageing, the Minister for Health or the Minister for Health Industries according to the distribution of Ministerial responsibilities and functions between the relevant Ministers so that the reference will have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister to whom the relevant responsibilities or functions are currently assigned.
- (4) A reference to the Minister for State/Local Government Relations in an Act, a statutory instrument under an Act or any other kind of instrument, or a contract, agreement or other document will have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister for Local Government.
- (5) A reference to the Minister for Planning in an Act or a statutory instrument under an Act will, if the Act was, on the day immediately before the effective date, committed to the administration of that Minister, have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister to whom the administration of the Act is for the time being committed.
- (6) A reference to the Minister for Planning in a statutory instrument or any other kind of instrument, or a contract, agreement or other document, made or entered into before the effective date (other than a reference to which subclause (5) is applicable) will have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister for Planning or the Minister for Local Government according to the distribution of Ministerial responsibilities and functions between the relevant Ministers so that the reference will have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister to whom the relevant responsibilities or functions are currently assigned.
- (7) A reference to the Minister for Transport Services in an Act, a statutory instrument under an Act or any other kind of instrument, or a contract, agreement or other document will have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister for Transport and Infrastructure.

(8) In this clause—

*effective date* means the date on which this proclamation is made.
