FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, those holders of a licence issued pursuant to the Scheme of Management (Rock Lobster Fisheries) Regulations 1991, shown in Schedule 1 (hereinafter referred to as the 'permit holder') are exempt from the Fisheries Act 1982 but only insofar as the permit holder shall not be guilty of an offence when using more than the number of rock lobster pots endorsed on his licence, (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity') subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 2.

SCHEDULE 2

1. This permit is valid from 25 November 1999 to 18 December 1999.
2. The permit holder must use no more than 30 additional rock lobster pots above his permitted allocation.
3. The permit holder must not conduct the permitted activity unless an officer from the South Australian Research and Development Institute is on board the boat.
4. The permit holder must comply with all instructions given by an officer of the South Australian Research and Development Institute.
5. Whilst engaged in the permitted activity the permit holder must have in his possession a copy of this notice and produce a copy of the notice if required by a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer.
6. The permit holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under the Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, G. Ward (hereinafter referred to as the 'fisher'), 37 Esplanade, Kingston, S.A. 5223, holder of northern zone rock lobster fishery N020 is exempt from the provisions of licence condition No. 161 subject to the conditions set out in the Schedule from the date of gazettal of this notice until 29 November 1999.

THE SCHEDULE

1. The fisher must ensure all rock lobster pots left in the water are unbaited.
2. The fisher must, upon retrieval of the rock lobster pots, release into the water any rock lobster retained within the pots.
3. The fisher shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any Regulation made under that Act or any condition of her licence, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
4. While engaged in the permitted activity the fisher shall have in their possession a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.
