FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 43

TAKE notice that, pursuant to the Fisheries Act 1982, it is hereby declared that it shall be unlawful for any persons to engage in the act or an act preparatory to or involved in the taking of fish from those waters specified in the Schedule from 1 July 2000 until this notice is revoked by the Director of Fisheries.

SCHEDULE

All the waters of Lake George situated in the Hundreds of Lake George and Rivoli Bay.

FISHERIES ACT 1982 : SECTION 59

TAKE NOTICE that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Peter Heylen (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder'), 31 Jikara Drive, Glen Osmond, S.A. 5064 is exempt from section 44 of the Fisheries Act 1982, but only insofar as the exemption holder may take non-native fish for sale by the use of purse seine nets, gill nets, drum nets, lures and handlines (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity') from the Mount Bold reservoir, subject to the conditions set out in the Schedule from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2001.

SCHEDULE

1. The exemption holder shall ensure that whilst conducting the permitted activity, he meets all conditions and requirements of SA Water.

2. All native fish caught must be returned to the water.

3. The exemption holder shall provide the following information, which is to be recorded on a daily basis when fishing, and provide this information to the Director of Fisheries on a monthly basis, within 14 days after the end of each month:

- the weight of catch for each species;
- the time spent searching and fishing (handlining only);
- the number of nets used and the duration of each set;

4. The exemption holder may use one agent to assist him with the permitted activity, provided that agent operates with the exemption holder and from the same vessel.

5. All fish transported for sale, shall be transported in bins clearly marked with the number MTB1 and the name, Peter Heylen.

6. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act or any condition of this notice, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

7. While engaged in the permitted activity the exemption holder shall have in his possession a copy of this notice and such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.
