FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Todreel Pty Ltd, 1 Port Road, Hindmarsh, S.A. 5007 (hereinafter referred to as the 'fisher') are exempt from the provisions of Clause 61A (1) (c) and (e) of Schedule 1 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1984, in that the fisher shall not be guilty of an offence when using a boat which exceeds 15.2 m in length and 300 continuous brake horse power and use trawl nets with a combined headline length greater than 27.43 m pursuant to Gulf St Vincent prawn fishery licence V06 (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity') subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1.

SCHEDULE 1

1. The fisher may engage in the permitted activity from the date of gazettal of this notice until 31 December 2000.

2. The fisher may only engage in the permitted activity using the boat *Anna Pearl*.

3. The fisher must use no more than two trawl nets at any one time from the boat *Anna Pearl*. The maximum combined headline length for all trawl nets used at any one time must not exceed 29.26 m and the headline length of any single trawl net used must not exceed 14.63 m.

4. Whilst engaged in the permitted activity the fisher must have in their possession a copy of this notice and produce a copy of the notice if required by a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer.

5. The fisher shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under the Act except where specifically exempted by this notice.
