FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Bruce Weir or his agent from Barmera-Moorook Field & Game (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder'), P.O. Box 380, Barmera, S.A. 5345 is exempt from section 41 of the Fisheries Act 1982, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1, in that the exemption holder shall not be guilty of an offence when taking carp (Family Cyprinidae) using a hauling net (the maximum length of which does not exceed 10 m with a minimum mesh size of 10 mm) (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted device') from waters of the Murray River (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity').

SCHEDULE 1

1. This exemption is valid from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2000.
 2. All native species taken pursuant to the permitted activity must be immediately returned to the water.
 3. Before collecting any specimens pursuant to this notice, the exemption holder must advise the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 with the details of the proposed locations and dates on which the collections are to be made.
 4. Whilst engaged in the permitted activity the exemption holder must have in his possession a copy of this notice and produce a copy of the notice if required by a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer.
 5. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under the Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

FISHERIES ACT 1982 : SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Water ECOscience Pty Ltd or its agents (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder'), 68 Ricketts Road, Mount Waverley, Vic. 3149 is exempt from section 41 of the Fisheries Act 1982 but only insofar as it may engage in the activities specified in Schedule 1 (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity'), subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 2 from the date of gazettal of this notice until 31 December 2000.

SCHEDULE 1

The collection of *Galaxias brevipinnis* using backpack electrofishing equipment from the waters of the Upper Onkaparinga Catchment Area.

SCHEDULE 2

1. The specimens collected by the exemption holder are for scientific and research purposes only and may not be sold. All fish must be returned to the water immediately upon completion of scientific evaluation.
 2. All electrofishing performed by the exemption holder must be in accordance with the Australian Code of Electrofishing Practice.
 3. Before collecting any specimens pursuant to this notice, the exemption holder must notify the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 with details of the proposed locations and the dates on which the collections are to be made.
 4. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
 5. While engaging in the permitted activity, the exemption holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.
