FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Howard J. Rodd, P.O. Box 2424, Port Lincoln, S.A. 5606, holder of marine scalefish fishery licence M138 (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') is exempt from the provisions of regulation 12 (2) of the Scheme of Management (Marine Scalefish Fisheries) Regulations 1991, in that the exemption holder shall not be guilty of an offence when using a registered master (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity'), subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1.

SCHEDULE 1

1. The exemption holder may engage in the permitted activity from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2001.
2. The exemption holder may only engage in the permitted activity for the taking of ocean leather jacket (*Nelusetta ayraudi*).
3. The exemption holder must nominate, on a form approved by the Director of Fisheries, the name and address of the person who is to act as his nominated master prior to the commencement of any fishing activity pursuant to this notice.
