- 1. We do, by this Our Commission under Our Sign Manual, appoint you the said Bruno Krumins to be, during Our pleasure, Our Lieutenant-Governor in and over Our State of South Australia in the Commonwealth of Australia with all the powers, rights, privileges and advantages belonging or appertaining to that Office.
- 2. And We do hereby authorise, empower and command you to exercise and perform the powers and functions appertaining to that Office.
- 3. And We do hereby declare that, so soon as you take the Oath of Allegiance and the Official Oath under Our Letters Patent constituting the Office of Governor of the State of South Australia, this Our present Commission will supersede the Commission, bearing date the Twenty-fifth day of March 1992, appointing Our Trusty and Well-beloved Basil Stuart Hetzel, Companion of the Order of Australia, to be Lieutenant-Governor of Our State of South Australia.
- 4. And We do hereby command all Our Officers, Ministers and loving subjects in Our State of South Australia, and all others whom it may concern, to take due notice hereof and to give their ready obedience accordingly.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Kathy Heinze or her agent (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') from CSIRO Land and Water, Waite Road, Urrbrae, S.A. 5064 is exempt from the provisions of the Fisheries Act 1982 but only insofar as she may engage in the activities specified in Schedule 1 (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity'), using the gear specified in Schedule 2, subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 3 from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 May 2002.

SCHEDULE 1

The collection of native and introduced fish, including those species protected pursuant to Section 42 of the Fisheries Act 1982 from the waters of the River Murray including backwaters and anabranches.

SCHEDULE 2

4 seine nets (the maximum length of which does not exceed 6 m with a minimum mesh size of 5 mm) and 4 gill nets (the maximum length of which does not exceed 20 m with a minimum mesh size of 40mm).

SCHEDULE 3

- 1. All native fish collected pursuant to this notice not required for scientific evaluation must be returned to the water on completion of the study.
- 2. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
- 3. The exemption holder must provide the Director of Fisheries with a report on the monitoring program conducted within 6 months of the completion of the program.
- 4. While engaging in the permitted activity, the exemption holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.
- 5. Before collecting any specimens pursuant to this notice, the exemption holder must provide a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer (telephone 1800 065 522) with details of the proposed locations and the dates on which the collections are to be made.
