FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, David Ayres, 447 Waggon Road, Victor Harbor, S.A. 5211 (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') is exempt from the Fisheries Act 1982, but only insofar as he may use up to 100 octopus traps for the purpose of trade or business (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 1 from 1 July 2001 until 31 December 2001.

SCHEDULE 1

- 1. The exempted activity must only be conducted from a boat registered on Marine Scalefish Fishery Licence No. M206.
- 2. The exemption holder must return all species other than octopus (*Octopus spp.*) to the water when conducting the exempted activity.
- 3. When conducting the exempted activity the ∞ topus traps may be baited and must not have a maximum dimension exceeding 1 m.
- 4. The exemption holder must provide the Director of Fisheries with statistical catch and effort information, (including zero returns if no fish have been collected) in the form of a written report, within 15 days of the completion of each calendar month. This report is to include the following information:
 - · Dates of fishing activity.
 - Exact locations of fishing activity.
 - Total weight of fish collected.
 - Mean size of fish collected.
 - Weight and use of any fish sold.
- 5. Whilst engaged in the exempted activity the exemption holder must have in his possession a copy of this notice and produce a copy of the notice if required by a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer.
- 6. The exemption holder must not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act except where specifically exempted by this notice. Dated 28 May 2001.

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Garry North, 6 Simmons Street, Port Lincoln, S.A. 5606 (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') is exempt from the Fisheries Act 1982, but only insofar as he may use up to 100 octopus traps for the purpose of trade or business (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 1 from 1 July 2001 until 31 December 2001.

SCHEDULE 1

- 1. The exempted activity must only be conducted from a boat registered on Marine Scalefish Fishery Licence No. M250.
- 2. The exemption holder must return all species other than octopus (*Octopus spp.*) to the water when conducting the exempted activity.
- 3. When conducting the exempted activity the octopus traps may be baited and must not have a maximum dimension exceeding $1\ \mathrm{m}$.
- 4. The exemption holder must provide the Director of Fisheries with statistical catch and effort information, (including zero returns if no fish have been collected) in the form of a written report, within 15 days of the completion of each calendar month. This report is to include the following information:
 - · Dates of fishing activity.
 - · Exact locations of fishing activity.
 - · Total weight of fish collected.
 - Mean size of fish collected.
 - · Weight and use of any fish sold.
- 5. Whilst engaged in the exempted activity the exemption holder must have in his possession a copy of this notice and produce a copy of the notice if required by a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer.
- 6. The exemption holder must not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act except where specifically exempted by this notice. Dated 28 May 2001.
