- (b) a reference to the Minister for Human Services in an Act or a statutory instrument under an Act will, if the Act was on the day immediately before the effective date, committed to the administration of that Minister, have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister to whom the administration of the Act is for the time being committed;

- (c) a reference to the Minister for Human Services in a statutory instrument or any other kind of instrument, or a contract, agreement or other document, made or entered into before the effective date (other than a reference to which paragraph (b) is applicable) will have effect as a reference to the Minister for Health, the Minister for Housing or the Minister for Social Justice according to the distribution of Ministerial functions and liabilities between the relevant Ministers so that the reference will have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister to whom the relevant responsibilities or functions are currently assigned;
- (d) a reference to the Minister for Industry and Trade in an Act or a statutory instrument under an Act will, if the Act was on the day immediately before the effective date, committed to that Minister, have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister to whom the administration of the Act is for the time being committed;
- (e) a reference to the Minister for Industry and Trade in a statutory instrument or any other kind of instrument, or a contract, agreement or other document, made or entered into before the effective date (other than a reference to which paragraph (d) is applicable) will have effect as a reference to the Minister for Industry, Investment and Trade;
- (f) a reference to the Minister for Transport and Urban Planning in an Act or a statutory instrument under an Act will, if the Act was on the day immediately before the effective date, committed to the administration of that Minister, have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister to whom the administration of the Act is for the time being committed;
- (g) a reference to the Minister for Transport and Urban Planning in a statutory instrument or any other kind of instrument, or a contract, agreement or other document, made or entered into before the effective date (other than a reference to which paragraph (f) is applicable) will have effect as a reference to the Minister for Transport or the Minister for Urban Development and Planning according to the distribution of Ministerial functions and liabilities between the relevant Ministers so that the reference will have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister to whom the relevant responsibilities or functions are currently assigned;
- (h) a reference to the Minister for Environment and Heritage in an Act or a statutory instrument under an Act will, if the Act was on the day immediately before the effective date, committed to that Minister, have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister to whom the administration of the Act is for the time being committed;

- (l) a reference to the Minister for Employment and Training in an Act or a statutory instrument under an Act will, if the Act was on the day immediately before the effective date, committed to that Minister, have effect as if it were a reference to the Minister to whom the administration of the Act is for the time being committed;

ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS ACT 1994 SECTION 7: CONSTITUTION OF MINISTERS AS BODIES CORPORATE; TRANSFER OF ASSETS, RIGHTS AND LIABILITIES

Proclamation By The Governor

(L.S.) MARJORIE JACKSON-NELSON

PURSUANT to section 7 of the *Administrative Arrangements Act 1994* and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, I—

1. Dissolve the bodies corporate referred to in Schedule 1.
2. Constitute the Ministers referred to in Schedule 2 as bodies corporate.
3. (1) Vest the assets and rights and attach the liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for State and Regional Development in the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Economic Development or the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Regional Affairs according to the distribution of Ministerial responsibilities and functions between the relevant Ministers so that assets, rights and liabilities appropriate to particular responsibilities or functions vest in, or attach to, the appropriate body corporate.
- (2) Vest the assets and rights and attach the liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Human Services in the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Housing, the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Health or the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Social Justice according to the distribution of Ministerial responsibilities and functions between the relevant Ministers so that assets, rights and liabilities appropriate to particular responsibilities or functions vest in, or attach to, the appropriate body corporate.
- (3) Vest the assets and rights and attach the liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Industry and Trade in the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Industry, Investment and Trade.
- (4) Vest the assets and rights and attach the liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Transport and Urban Planning in the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Transport or the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Urban Development and Planning according to the distribution of Ministerial responsibilities and functions between the relevant Ministers so that assets, rights and liabilities appropriate to particular responsibilities or functions vest in, or attach to, the appropriate body corporate.
- (5) Vest the assets and rights and attach the liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Environment and Heritage in the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Environment and Conservation.
- (6) Vest the assets and rights and attach the liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Water Resources in the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Environment and Conservation or the body corporate to be known as the Minister for the River Murray according to the distribution of Ministerial responsibilities and functions between the relevant Ministers so that assets, rights and liabilities appropriate to particular responsibilities or functions vest in, or attach to, the appropriate body corporate.

(7) Vest the assets and rights and attach the liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Employment and Training in the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Employment, Training and Further Education.

(8) Vest the assets and rights and attach the liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Police, Correctional Services and Emergency Services in the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Police, the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Emergency Services or the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Correctional Services according to the distribution of Ministerial responsibilities and functions between the relevant Ministers so that assets, rights and liabilities appropriate to particular responsibilities or functions vest in, or attach to, the appropriate body corporate.

(9) Vest the assets and rights and attach the liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Minerals and Energy in the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Mineral Resources Development or the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Energy according to the distribution of Ministerial responsibilities and functions between the relevant Ministers so that assets, rights and liabilities appropriate to particular responsibilities or functions vest in, or attach to, the appropriate body corporate.

(10) Vest the assets and rights and attach the liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Workplace Services in the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Industrial Relations.

(11) Vest the assets and rights and attach the liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Administrative and Information Services in the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Science and Information Economy or the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Administrative Services according to the distribution of Ministerial responsibilities and functions between the relevant Ministers so that assets, rights and liabilities appropriate to particular responsibilities or functions vest in, or attach to, the appropriate body corporate.

(12) Vest the assets and rights and attach the liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Aboriginal Affairs in the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Aboriginal Affairs and Reconciliation.

(13) Vest the assets and rights and attach the liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Primary Industries in the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Agriculture, Food and Fisheries.

(14) Vest the assets and rights and attach the liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Innovation in the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Science and Information Economy.

(15) Vest the assets and rights and attach the liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for Disability Services in the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Social Justice.

(16) Vest the assets and rights and attach the liabilities of the former body corporate known as the Minister for the Ageing in the body corporate to be known as the Minister for Social Justice.
