FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Leslie Morrison or persons acting as her agents (the 'exemption holders') from the School of Biological Sciences, Flinders University of South Australia, G.P.O. Box 2100, Adelaide, S.A. 5001 are exempt from section 41 of the Fisheries Act 1982 but only insofar as they may engage in the activities specified in Schedule 1 using the gear specified in Schedule 2 (the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 3, from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2004, unless varied or revoked earlier.

SCHEDULE 1

The collection of marine organisms from all waters of South Australia including intertidal 'rocky' reefs, excluding aquatic reserves.

SCHEDULE 2

- 2 beach seine nets (the maximum length of which does not exceed 50 m)
- 5 drop nets
- 2 plankton nets
- 1 beam trawl net (the maximum width of which does not exceed 2 m)
- 1 cast net
- 10 fish traps
- 1 miniature otter trawl
- hook and line
- butterfly/dab nets
- 1 bait pump

SCHEDULE 3

1. The specimens collected by the exemption holders are for scientific and research purposes only and must not be sold.
2. Before collecting any specimens pursuant to this notice, the exemption holders must advise the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 with details of the proposed locations and the dates on which the collections are to be made.

3. The exemption holders must provide a report in writing detailing the outcomes of the research and the collection of organisms pursuant to this notice to the Director of Fisheries, (Attention: Kristy Power, P.O. Box 282, Port Adelaide, S.A. 5015) within three months of the expiry of this notice, giving the following details:

- the date, time and location of collection;
- the description of all species collected; and
- the number of each species collected.

4. While engaging in the exempted activity, the exemption holders must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.

5. The exemption holders shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that, pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Michael G. Jolly, P.O. Box 54, Goolwa, S.A. 5214, holder of Marine Scalefish Fishery Licence No. M236 (the 'exemption holder'), is exempt from sub-regulation 15 (2) of the Scheme of Management (Marine Scalefish Fisheries) Regulations 1991 but only insofar as the exemption holder shall not be guilty of an offence when permitting more than two persons to act as his agents on the shore when fishing for cockles (Suborder Teledonta), pursuant to licence number M236 (the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1, from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2004, unless varied or revoked earlier.

SCHEDULE 1

1. The exemption holder must not cause or permit more than nine persons to act as his agents at any one time whilst conducting the exempted activity.

2. The exemption holder must be present at all times whilst the exempted activity is being conducted.

3. The exemption holder must be within 500 m of all agents conducting fishing activities pursuant to this exemption.

4. While engaged in the exempted activity, the exemption holder must carry or have about or near his person, a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries compliance officer upon request.

5. The exemption holder must not contravene or fail to comply with the *Fisheries Act 1982*, or any regulation made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 43

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 43 of the Fisheries Act 1982 it is hereby declared unlawful for a person to engage in the fishing activity described in Schedule 1 in the area specified in Schedule 2 from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2004 inclusive, unless this notice is revoked or varied earlier.

SCHEDULE 1

Fishing, other than fishing undertaken in accordance with a commercial fishery licence granted under section 34 of the Fisheries Act 1982, using the types and number of devices listed below:

1. a drum net; or
2. a fish net; or
3. a set line/cross line; or
4. more than 1 hand net at any one time; or
5. more than 1 shrimp trap at any one time; or
6. more than 3 yabbie pots at any one time; or
7. more than 3 drop nets at any one time; or
8. more than 10 hoop nets at any one time; or
9. yabbie pots and drop nets at the same time; or
10. more than 3 hoop nets when both a hand net and a shrimp trap are being used at the same time.

SCHEDULE 2

All inland waters of the State other than the waters of the River Murray, the Coorong, Lakes Albert and Alexandrina and Lake George.
