FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Darren Hicks of Australian Water Quality Centre, PMB 3, Salisbury, S.A. 5108 (the 'exemption holder'), or his agents, is exempt from section 41 of the Fisheries Act 1982 and the Fisheries (General) Regulations 2000 but only insofar as the exemption holder may engage in the collection of aquatic organisms in the waters specified in Schedule 1, using the gear specified in Schedule 2 (the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 3, from the date of gazettal of this notice until 29 February 2004, unless varied or revoked earlier.

SCHEDULE 1

The waters below the following reservoirs:

- Myponga Reservoir,
- Little Para Reservoir,
- Mount Bold Reservoir,
- South Para Reservoir,
- Kangaroo Creek Reservoir.

SCHEDULE 2

1 dab net per person.

1 seine net with a maximum length of 25 m and a minimum mesh size of 15 mm.

1 seine net with a maximum length of 3.5 m and a minimum mesh size of 8 mm.

1 seine net with a maximum length of 6 m and a minimum mesh size of 12 mm.

40 fish traps with a maximum size of 40 cm x 25 cm, with a minimum opening of 5 cm.

SCHEDULE 3

1. The specimens collected by the exemption holder are for scientific and research purposes only and must not be sold.

2. On completion of scientific assessment, all native fish captured must be released into the area of capture and non-native fish must be disposed of appropriately.

3. Before collecting any specimens pursuant to this notice, the exemption holder must advise the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 with the names of the people undertaking the exempted activity, the proposed locations and the dates on which the collections are to be made.

4. While engaging in the exempted activity, the exemption holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.

5. The exemption holder must not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Cameron Amos of WSL Consultants Pty Ltd, 2-8 Harvey Street, Richmond, Vic. 3121 or persons acting as his agents (the 'exemption holders') is exempt from the provision of section 41 of the Fisheries Act 1982 and the Fisheries (General) Regulations 2000 insofar as they may engage in the collection of fish (the 'exempted activity') from the waters described in Schedule 1, using the gear specified in Schedule 2, subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 3 from the date of gazettal of this notice until 31 December 2004, unless varied or revoked earlier.

- 15 fish traps.
- 1 seine net (minimum mesh size of 10 mm, maximum length of 15 m and maximum drop of 2 m).
- 1 dip net per person.

SCHEDULE 3

1. The specimens collected by the exemption holders are for scientific and research purposes only and must not be sold.

2. All native fish taken pursuant to the exempted activity must be immediately returned to the water unless retained for the purpose of species identification.

3. A maximum of 5 fish of any species per location may be taken for the purpose of species identification.

4. Before conducting the exempted activity, the exemption holders must advise the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 with the name of the person or persons who will be conducting the exempted activity, details of the proposed locations and the dates on which the collections are to be made.

5. The exemption holders must provide a report in writing detailing collection of organisms pursuant to this notice to the Director of Fisheries, (Attention: Kristy Power, P.O. Box 282, Port Adelaide, S.A. 5015) within 14 days of any collection, giving the following details:

- the date, time and location of collection;
- the description of all species collected; and
- the number of each species collected.

6. While engaging in the exempted activity, the exemption holders must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA fisheries compliance officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.

7. The exemption holders shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Nick Kirby from the Melbourne Aquarium, corner of Kings Way and Queens Wharf Road, Melbourne, Vic. 3000 (the 'exemption holder'), or his agents, is exempt from the provisions of the Fisheries Act 1982 and clauses 1 and 48 of Schedule 1 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 2000 but only insofar as the exemption holder may take bronze whaler sharks (*Carcharhinus brachyurus*) using the devices listed in Schedule 1, in the areas described in Schedule 2 (the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 3, from 15 December 2003 until 30 June 2004, unless varied or revoked earlier.

SCHEDULE 1

- Wire trace greater than 2 mm gauge.
- Anaesthetics, including veterinary chemicals.

SCHEDULE 2

Waters within Encounter Bay, excluding the Granite Island Conservation Zone.

SCHEDULE 3

1. The specimens collected by the exemption holders are for live display purposes only and must not be sold.

2. A maximum of four bronze whaler sharks (*Carcharhinus brachyurus*) may be taken pursuant to this notice.

3. Bronze whaler sharks may only be taken pursuant to this licence if they are a more than 1 m and less than 2 m in length.

4. At least 24 hours prior to collecting any specimens pursuant to this notice, the exemption holders must advise PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 with details of the proposed locations, the dates on which the collections are to be made and names of any agents he will be engaging to collect specimens.

5. The exemption holders must provide a report in writing detailing the collection of specimens pursuant to this notice to the Director of Fisheries, (Attention: Kristy Power, P.O. Box 282, Port Adelaide, S.A. 5015) within 14 days of any collection or attempted collection, giving the following details:

- the date and time of collection or attempted collection;
- the description of any specimens collected; and
- the condition of any specimens collected (including any fatalities).

6. While engaging in the exempted activity, the exemption holders or their agents must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Officer if requested.

7. The exemption holders must not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
