FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Greg Ward (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder'), 37 Esplanade, Kingscote, S.A. 5223, is exempted from subsection 34 (1) of the Fisheries Act 1982 and regulations 5 and 6 of the Scheme of Management (Miscellaneous Fishery) Regulations 2000 but only insofar as he is not required to hold a fishing licence to use no more than 60 registered rock lobster pots to take spider crab (*Maja Squinado*) for trade or business (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 1, from 20 March 2003 until 27 March 2003 and 19 May 2003 to 25 May 2003, unless this notice is varied or revoked earlier.

SCHEDULE 1

1. The rock lobster pots must have a tag attached to the buoy that is marked with the name and address of the exemption holder.

2. All fish other than spider crabs (*Maja Squinado*) must be returned to the water immediately with as little injury as possible.

3. The exempted activity may only be undertaken in the coastal waters of St Vincent Gulf south of latitude 35°03.2'S and west of longitude 138°E and in Spencer Gulf south of latitude 34°26.75'S.

4. Whilst conducting the exempted activity, the exemption holder must only use a boat that is endorsed on Northern Zone Rock Lobster Licence No. N020.

5. The exemption holder must allow a PIRSA Fisheries Departmental Officer to accompany the exemption holder at any time during the exempted activity.

6. The exemption holder must provide a report in writing detailing the daily catch of spider crab (*Maja Squinado*), (Attention: Roger Hill, P.O. Box 282, Port Adelaide, S.A. 5015) by Monday, 9 June 2003.

7. While engaged in the exempted activity the exemption holder shall have in their possession a copy of this notice. Such notice

must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.

8. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any Regulation made under that Act or any condition of the licence, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

9. The exemption holder or a registered master listed on Northern Zone Rock Lobster Licence No. N020 shall notify the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 prior to conducting the permitted activity and provide the following information:

(a) the intended area of conducting the permitted activity; and

(b) the intended place and time of departure and landing.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Michael Hammer or persons acting as his agents (the 'exemption holder') of Native Fish Australia (SA) Inc, 120 Wakefield Street, Adelaide, S.A. 5000, is exempt from the provisions of the Fisheries Act 1982, but only insofar as the exemption holder may engage in the collection of fish within the inland waters of Kangaroo Island (the 'exempted activity'), using the gear specified in Schedule 1, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 2, from the date of gazettal of this notice until 31 March 2004, unless varied or revoked earlier.

3 seine nets, maximum length 25 m, minimum mesh 3 mm
 60 fish traps, maximum dimension 1 m, maximum entrance size 6 cm
 1 dab net per person
 6 fyke nets, maximum width 10 m, minimum mesh size 6 mm

SCHEDULE 2

1. All fish collected pursuant to this notice must be either returned to the water on completion of scientific evaluation or lodged with the South Australian Museum.

2. The exemption holder must provide a report in writing detailing the outcomes of the research and the collection of fish pursuant to this notice to the Director of Fisheries, (Attention: Roger Hill, P.O. Box 282, Port Adelaide, S.A. 5015) within 3 months of the expiry of this notice, giving details of the date, time and location of collection and the number of each species collected.

3. Before collecting any specimens pursuant to this notice, the exemption holder must advise the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 with details of the proposed locations and the dates on which the collections are to be made.

4. While engaging in the exempted activity, the exemption holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.

5. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
