Schedule 1—Restricted waters

### Part 1—Preliminary

#### 1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Harbors and Navigation (Control of Caulerpa Taxifolia) Variation Regulations 2005.* 

#### 2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

#### 3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

# Part 2—Variation of Harbors and Navigation (Control of Caulerpa Taxifolia) Regulations 2002

#### 4—Insertion of regulation 3A

After regulation 3 insert:

#### 3A—Application of regulations

These regulations are in addition to, and do not derogate from, any other law

#### 5—Variation of regulation 4—Restricted waters: s. 27

Regulation 4—delete "during the periods specified in that entry"

#### 6—Variation of regulation 5—Offences

Regulation 5(3)—delete subregulation (3) and substitute:

- (3) A prohibition applying in restricted waters according to the Schedule does not apply in relation to—
  - (a) if the restricted waters are within a port—the port operator, or a person authorised by the port operator, in carrying out activities necessary for the operation and maintenance of the port; or
  - (b) in any case—an authorised person in the exercise of powers under the Act or regulations under the Act.

#### 7—Substitution of Schedule

Schedule—delete the Schedule and substitute:

#### Schedule 1—Restricted waters


The map in this Schedule is provided for convenience of reference only.

#### Waters

All waters of the Port River south of an east west line from Snapper Point to Torrens Island and all waters of the North Arm, Eastern Passage, Angas Inlet, Torrens Reach and Barker Inlet south of a east west line passing through Middleground Beacon.

#### **Prohibited activities**

The anchoring of a vessel in the waters
