FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 43

TAKE notice that it is hereby declared that it shall be unlawful for any person to engage in the act of taking or the act preparatory to or involved in the taking of western king prawn (*Penaeus latisulcatus*) in waters of Gulf St Vincent outside of the two areas specified in Schedule 1 during the periods specified in Schedule 2.

SCHEDULE 1

1. The area commencing at position latitude 34°55.00'S, longitude 138°07.00'E, then to the position latitude 34°57.80'S, longitude 138°07.00'E, then to the position latitude 34°57.80'S, longitude 138°09.00'E, then to the position latitude 35°00.50'S, longitude 138°08.30'E, then to the position latitude 35°00.50'S, longitude 138°01.90'E, then to the position latitude 34°55.00'S, longitude 138°02.50'E, then to the point of commencement position latitude 34°55.00'S, longitude 138°07.00'E.

2. The area commencing at position latitude 35°00.50'S, longitude 138°08.50'E, then to the position latitude 35°04.00'S, longitude 138°08.50'E, then to the position latitude 35°04.00'S, longitude 138°01.90'E, then to the position latitude 35°00.50'S, longitude 138°01.90'E, then to the point of commencement position latitude 35°00.50'S, longitude 138°08.50'E.

From 2000 hours on 14 March 2005 to 0700 hours on 19 March 2005.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Nick Kirby from the Melbourne Aquarium, Corner Kings Way and Queens Wharf Road, Melbourne, Vic. 3000 (the 'exemption holder') or a person acting as his agent is exempt from the provisions of the Fisheries Act 1982 and clauses 1 and 48 of Schedule 1 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 2000, but only insofar as the exemption holder may take a total of six sharks (the 'exempted activity') from the waters of South Australia utilising the gear specified in Schedule 1 subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 2 from 14 March 2005 until 31 May 2005, unless varied or revoked earlier.

SCHEDULE 1

- Longlines currently endorsed as registered devices on Marine Scalefish Fishery Licence No. M053, held by Nigel Cranfield.

SCHEDULE 2

1. Only bronze whaler or dusky whaler sharks may be taken pursuant to this exemption.

2. The specimens collected by the exemption holder are for display purposes only and must not be sold.

3. The exempted activity may only be conducted on the exemption holder's behalf by Robert C. Mort and Nigel Cranfield.

4. At least 24 hours prior to collecting any specimens pursuant to this notice, the exemption holder must advise PIRSA Fisheries Compliance on 1800 065 522 and answer a series of questions about the exempted activity. The exemption holder will need to have a copy of the exemption with them at the time of making the call, and be able to provide information about the area and time of the exempted activity, the vehicles/boats involved, the number of agents undertaking the exempted activity and any other related questions.

5. The exemption holder must provide a report in writing detailing the collection of specimens pursuant to this notice to the Director of Fisheries, (G.P.O. Box 1625, Adelaide, S.A. 5001) within 14 days of any collection or attempted collection, giving the following details:

- the date and time of collection or attempted collection;
- the description of any specimen collected; and
- the condition of any specimen collected (including any fatalities).

6. While engaged in the exempted activity, the exemption holders or their agents must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Officer if requested.

7. The exemption holder must not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
