NATIONAL ELECTRICITY (SOUTH AUSTRALIA) ACT 1996

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 5 (6) OF THE NATIONAL
ELECTRICITY LAW

Tasmania's entry to the National Electricity Market

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to section 5 (6) of the National Electricity Law, which forms the Schedule to the National Electricity (South Australia) Act 1996 that Tasmania became a participating jurisdiction within the meaning of the National Electricity Law on 29 May 2005. This is based on:

- advice from the three Tasmanian electricity entities confirming that each has completed all preconditions required for Tasmania to enter and for it to participate in the National Electricity Market;
- advice from NEMMCO that it is ready for Tasmania to become a participating jurisdiction in the NEM;
- commencement of the Electricity—National Scheme (Tasmania) Act 1999, effective from 29 May 2005.

- commencement of the relevant sections of the Electricity Supply Industry Amendment Act 2003, effective 29 May 2005, facilitating Tasmania's entry into the National Electricity Market; and
- incorporation of Tasmania's derogations into the National Electricity Code.

The Code derogations referred to above and a copy of the letter from the Premier and Treasurer of Tasmania, Paul Lennon MLA, dated 9 May 2005 confirming those details, can be viewed on the internet website of National Electricity Code Administrator Limited (ACN 073 942 775) ('NECA') at www.neca.com.au under 'The Code—Tasmania's entry to the National Electricity Market' section of that website.
