LIVESTOCK ACT 1997, SECTION 37: DECLARATION OF A
LIVESTOCK STANDSTILL IN RELATION TO HORSES,
DONKEYS, ASSES AND MULES

*Notice under the Livestock Act 1997 for Preventing the
Introduction and Spread of Equine Influenza*

(Notice by Minister for Agriculture, Food and Fisheries)

BY virtue of the provisions of the Livestock Act 1997 and for the purpose of preventing the introduction to, and spread within, the State of South Australia of the declared exotic disease Equine Influenza, I do hereby:

1. Prohibit the introduction of any horses, donkeys, asses or mules into the State of South Australia, except as provided in any written authority given by an Inspector duly appointed under the Livestock Act 1997; and

2. Prohibit the travelling or movement of any horses, donkeys, asses or mules within the State of South Australia, except as provided in any written authority given by an Inspector duly appointed under the Livestock Act 1997.

This Notice shall remain in force for a period of 72.5 hours commencing at 12.30 p.m. on Tuesday, 28 August 2007, unless amended or revoked by subsequent notice.
