

ENDED 30 SEPTEMBER 2006 AND 30 SEPTEMBER 2005*****Receipts****Taxation*

Payroll tax receipts for the first three months of 2006-07 were higher than for the same period in the previous year reflecting growth in taxable payrolls.

Higher levels of stamp duty receipts in the September quarter 2006 compared to the same period a year ago reflect underlying strength in the property market and a large one-off payment of insurance duty relating to prior periods.

No debits tax was receipted in the September quarter 2006 reflecting the abolition of the tax with effect from 1 July 2005, resulting in only residual collections in the September quarter 2005.

Land tax collections in the September quarter 2006 are higher than for September quarter 2005 largely because of the introduction from the 2005-06 assessment year of optional quarterly billing. This has the effect of smoothing the quarterly pattern of land tax collections, whereas collections in September quarter 2005 reflect a payment profile consistent with annual billing. Collections in September quarter 2005 are mainly residual liabilities relating to the 2004-05 assessment year.

Gambling tax receipts were higher in the first three months of 2006-07, compared to the same period a year ago, reflecting higher expenditure on gaming machines in hotels and clubs.

*Fees and Charges*

The Land Services Group of the Department of Administrative and Information Services collects regulated fees and charges through various land administration Acts administered under the statutory authority of the Registrar-General and the Surveyor-General. Previously, these receipts were transferred to Consolidated Account net of the cost of the Land Services Group operations, as a dividend payment. The total land services receipts are now transferred to Consolidated Account and the Land Services Group are funded for their costs. As a result, these receipts have been reclassified as Fees and Charges. This revised treatment accounts for the variation between the total fees and charges collected for the quarter ended 30 September 2006 compared with the same period last financial year.

*Royalties*

The increase in royalty revenue between September quarter 2005 and September quarter 2006 is affected by differences between the years in the timing of royalty receipts from Olympic Dam. The quarterly royalty instalment from Olympic Dam that was due in September quarter 2005 was not received until October 2005. Consequently, the September quarter 2005 figure does not include any royalty from Olympic Dam whereas the September quarter 2006 figure does.

### *Commonwealth—General Purpose Grants*

The small increase in general purpose Commonwealth grants between September quarter 2005 and September quarter 2006 reflects differences between years in the pattern of monthly GST cash payments by the Commonwealth and is not indicative of underlying GST revenue growth.

### *Commonwealth—Specific Purpose Grants*

The decrease in the level of Commonwealth Specific Purpose Payments in the first three months of this year, compared to the same period last year, reflects the finalisation in 2005-06 of debt redemption assistance payments by the Commonwealth.

### *Other Receipts*

Other receipts are lower in the September 2006 quarter compared to the September 2005 quarter mainly due to SA Water's repayment of equity capital contribution made in July 2005 in line with the 2005-06 Budget. Interest recoveries are also lower in the September 2006 quarter due to the repayment of several loans during the 2005-06 financial year. Proceeds from the sale of the CBA Lease Vehicles in the September 2005 quarter were a one-off receipt and as such also contribute to the variation between the September 2006 and September 2005 quarters.

### **Payments**

Payments have been made pursuant to the *Supply Act* and in accordance with various Acts for which specific appropriation has been authorised.

Payments made from the Consolidated Account during the first quarter of 2006-07 were only slightly higher than the same period in 2005-06.

### **Note**

Considerable caution should be exercised in interpreting the quarterly statement of Consolidated Account transactions. Unlike the State budget, which comprises transactions on an accrual basis, the information reflected in the quarterly statements is limited to cash transactions. In addition, the Consolidated Account does not capture all the transactions undertaken by the general government sector (in particular, it does not record receipts to and payments from special deposit accounts). Finally, it should be noted that the timing of receipts and payments could be volatile within a particular year. As a result, apparently significant movements between years may only be due to changes in the timing of receipts and payments, and therefore may not have implications for the underlying budget position.

### **1—Short title**

This notice may be cited as the *Aquaculture (Approval of Lower Eyre Peninsula Zones Policy) Notice 2007*.

### **2—Approval of aquaculture policy**

- (1) The *Aquaculture (Zones—Lower Eyre Peninsula) Policy 2007* is approved.
- (2) The policy comes into operation on the day on which this notice is published in the Gazette.

#### **Schedule 6—Revocation of *Eyre Region-Lincoln Sub Region Zone Policy***

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## Part 1—Preliminary

### 1—Short title

This policy may be cited as the *Aquaculture (Zones—Lower Eyre Peninsula) Policy 2007*.

### 2—Interpretation

In this policy, unless the contrary intention appears—

*Act* means the *Aquaculture Act 2001*;

*finfish* means members of the classes *Actinopterygii*, *Chondrichthyes*, *Myxini* and *Petromyzontiformes*;

*GDA94* means the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 (as defined in the Commonwealth Gazette GN35 of 6 September 1995);

*lease* means an aquaculture lease;

*leased area* means an area subject to a lease;

*licence* means an aquaculture licence;

*prescribed wild caught tuna* means members of the genera *Allothunnus*, *Auxis*, *Euthunnus*, *Katsuwonus*, and *Thunnus* that have been taken from the wild.

#### Note—

Unless the contrary intention appears, terms used in this policy that are defined in the Act have the respective meanings assigned to those terms by the Act.

### 3—Zones

- (1) Pursuant to section 11 of the Act, this policy—
  - (a) identifies aquaculture zones and an aquaculture exclusion zone; and
  - (b) specifies for an aquaculture zone—
    - (i) the classes of aquaculture permitted in the zone; and
    - (ii) prescribed criteria to be taken into account in the determination of applications for licences or in the making of other decisions under the Act in relation to the zone.
- (2) This policy does not limit the matters that may be taken into account in the determination of applications for licences or in the making of other decisions under the Act.

### 4—Prescribed criteria for all aquaculture zones

In the determination of applications for licences and in the making of other decisions under the Act in relation to the aquaculture zones in this policy, it must be taken into account that, of the aggregated area leased or available for lease in those zones, 5 hectares must be used or available for use for the farming of aquatic organisms for the purposes of research.

### 5—Variation or revocation of Gazette notice

The Minister may vary or revoke a notice in the Gazette made by this policy by subsequent notice in the Gazette.

## **Part 2—Louth Bay intertidal and subtidal aquaculture zone**

### **6—Identification of aquaculture zone**

The Louth Bay intertidal and subtidal aquaculture zone is comprised of the waters delineated in the map in Schedule 2 as the Louth Bay intertidal and subtidal aquaculture zone.

### **7—Class of permitted aquaculture**

The classes of aquaculture permitted in the Louth Bay intertidal and subtidal aquaculture zone are—

- (a) the farming of finfish other than prescribed wild caught tuna; and
- (b) the farming of molluscs.

### **8—Prescribed criteria**

In the determination of applications for licences and in the making of other decisions under the Act in relation to the Louth Bay intertidal and subtidal aquaculture zone, the following prescribed criteria must be taken into account:

- (a) the zone must not contain more than 170 hectares of leased area for the farming of finfish other than prescribed wild caught tuna;
- (b) the zone must not contain more than 295 hectares of leased area for the farming of molluscs;
- (c) the aggregate biomass of finfish other than prescribed wild caught tuna being farmed in the waters in the zone at any one time must not exceed 1 020 tonnes or, if some other amount is determined by the Minister by notice in the Gazette, that other amount.

## **Part 3—Lincoln offshore subtidal aquaculture zone**

### **9—Identification of aquaculture zone**

The Lincoln offshore subtidal aquaculture zone is comprised of the waters delineated in the map in Schedule 3 as the Lincoln offshore subtidal aquaculture zone.

### **10—Class of permitted aquaculture**

The class of aquaculture permitted in the Lincoln offshore subtidal aquaculture zone is the farming of prescribed wild caught tuna.

### **11—Prescribed criteria**

In the determination of applications for licences and in the making of other decisions under the Act in relation to the Lincoln offshore subtidal aquaculture zone, the following prescribed criteria must be taken into account:

- (a) the zone must not contain more than 1 850 hectares of leased area;
- (b) the aggregate biomass of prescribed wild caught tuna being farmed in the waters in the zone at any one time must not exceed 10 500 tonnes or, if some other amount is determined by the Minister by notice in the Gazette, that other amount.

## **Part 4—Boston Bay intertidal and subtidal aquaculture zone**

### **12—Identification of aquaculture zone**

The Boston Bay intertidal and subtidal aquaculture zone is comprised of the waters delineated in the map in Schedule 4 as the Boston Bay intertidal and subtidal aquaculture zone.

### **13—Class of permitted aquaculture**

The classes of aquaculture permitted in the Boston Bay intertidal and subtidal aquaculture zone are—

- (a) the farming of finfish other than prescribed wild caught tuna; and
- (b) the farming of molluscs.

### **14—Prescribed criteria**


In the determination of applications for licences and in the making of other decisions under the Act in relation to the Boston Bay intertidal and subtidal aquaculture zone, it must be taken into account that the zone must not contain more than 262 hectares of leased area for the farming of molluscs or, if some other amount is determined by the Minister by notice in the Gazette, that other amount.



### Schedule 1—Map of all zones (overview)




## Schedule 2—Map of Louth Bay intertidal and subtidal aquaculture zone


### Schedule 3—Map of Lincoln offshore subtidal aquaculture zone


### Schedule 4—Map of Boston Bay intertidal and subtidal aquaculture zone

under section 43 of the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972*

---

### **Preamble**

- 1 The Crown land described in Schedule 1 is, by another proclamation made on this day, added to the Lake Gairdner National Park under section 28(2) of the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972*.
  - 2 It is intended that, by this proclamation, certain existing and future rights of entry, prospecting, exploration or mining be preserved in relation to the land added to the national park.
- 

### **1—Short title**

This proclamation may be cited as the *National Parks and Wildlife (Lake Gairdner National Park—Mining Rights) Proclamation 2007*.

### **2—Commencement**

This proclamation comes into operation on the day on which it is made.

### **3—Interpretation**

In this proclamation—

**Environment Minister** means the Minister for the time being administering the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972*;

**Mining Minister** means the Minister for the time being administering the *Mining Act 1971* or the Minister for the time being administering the *Petroleum Act 2000*, as the case requires.

### **4—Existing rights to continue**

Subject to clause 6, existing rights of entry, prospecting, exploration or mining under the *Mining Act 1971* or the *Petroleum Act 2000* may continue to be exercised in respect of the land described in Schedule 1.

### **5—New rights may be acquired**

Rights of entry, prospecting, exploration or mining may, with the approval of the Mining Minister and the Environment Minister, be acquired pursuant to the *Mining Act 1971* or the *Petroleum Act 2000* in respect of the land described in Schedule 1 and may, subject to clause 6, be exercised in respect of that land.

## 6—Conditions for exercise of rights

A person in whom rights of entry, prospecting, exploration or mining are vested pursuant to the *Mining Act 1971* or the *Petroleum Act 2000* (whether those rights were acquired before or after the making of this proclamation) must not exercise those rights in respect of the land described in Schedule 1 unless the person complies with the following conditions:

- (a) if work to be carried out in relation to the land in the exercise of rights under the *Petroleum Act 2000* is a regulated activity within the meaning of that Act, the person must ensure that—
  - (i) the work is not carried out until a statement of environmental objectives in relation to the activity that has been approved under that Act has also been approved by the Environment Minister; and
  - (ii) the work is carried out in accordance with the statement as so approved;
- (b) if work to be carried out in relation to the land in the exercise of rights under the *Mining Act 1971* or the *Petroleum Act 2000* has not previously been authorised (whether by inclusion in an approved statement of environmental objectives referred to in paragraph (a) or otherwise), the person must give at least 3 months notice of the proposed work to the Mining Minister and the Environment Minister and must supply each Minister with such information relating to the proposed work as the Minister may require;
- (c) if directions are agreed between the Mining Minister and the Environment Minister and given to the person in writing in relation to—
  - (i) carrying out work in relation to the land in a manner that minimises damage to the land (including the land's vegetation and wildlife) and the environment generally; or
  - (ii) preserving objects, structures or sites of historical, scientific or cultural interest; or
  - (iii) rehabilitating the land (including the land's vegetation and wildlife) on completion of the work; or
  - (iv) (where the work is being carried out in the exercise of rights acquired after the making of this proclamation) prohibiting or restricting access to any specified area of the land that the Ministers believe would suffer significant detriment as a result of carrying out the work,(being directions that do not reduce or otherwise detract from any requirement in respect of any of those matters contained in an approved statement of environmental objectives referred to in paragraph (a)), the person must comply with those directions in carrying out the work;
- (d) if a plan of management is in operation under section 38 of the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1972* in respect of the land, the person must have regard to the provisions of the plan of management;
- (e) in addition to complying with the other requirements of this proclamation, the person—
  - (i) must take such steps as are reasonably necessary to ensure that objects, structures and sites of historical, scientific or cultural interest and the land's vegetation and wildlife are not unduly affected by any work; and
  - (ii) must maintain all work areas in a clean and tidy condition; and

- (iii) must, on the completion of any work, obliterate or remove all installations and structures (other than installations and structures designated by the Mining Minister and the Environment Minister as suitable for retention) used exclusively for the purposes of that work;
- (f) if no direction has been given by the Mining Minister and the Environment Minister under paragraph (c)(iii), the person must (in addition to complying with any approved statement of environmental objectives referred to in paragraph (a)) rehabilitate the land (including its vegetation and wildlife) on completion of any work to the satisfaction of the Environment Minister.

### **7—Governor may give approvals, directions**

If—

- (a) the Mining Minister and the Environment Minister cannot agree as to whether—
  - (i) approval should be granted or refused under clause 5; or
  - (ii) a direction should be given under clause 6(c); or

### Part 1—Preliminary

#### 1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Harbors and Navigation Variation Regulations 2007*.

#### 2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

#### 3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

### Part 2—Variation of *Harbors and Navigation Regulations 1994*

#### 4—Variation of regulation 56—Compulsory pilotage: section 35

- (1) Regulation 56, entry related to Port Bonython—delete the entry and substitute:

Port Bonython (from the Port Pirie pilot station 2 nautical miles west of the northern light beacon on Eastern Shoal latitude 33°04.55'S, longitude 137°45.5'E)

- (2) Regulation 56, entry related to Port Pirie—after "Shoal" insert:

latitude 33°04.55'S, longitude 137°45.5'E

## 5—Insertion of regulation 151C

After regulation 151B insert:

### **151C—Vessels excluded from vicinity of OneSteel transshipment points in Spencer Gulf**

- (1) Vessels are prohibited from entering or remaining in waters within  $\frac{1}{2}$  nautical mile of a prescribed vessel while the prescribed vessel is, or is about to be, engaged in loading operations at a prescribed transshipment point.
- (2) The distance referred to in subregulation (1) is to be measured from each point of the outer edge of the prescribed vessel or any anchor, buoy or other equipment deployed from the prescribed vessel.
- (3) If a vessel enters or remains in waters in contravention of this regulation, the owner and the master or operator of the vessel are each guilty of an offence (but it is a defence to a charge of such an offence brought against the owner for the owner to prove that the vessel was operated in the manner constituting the offence without the owner's consent).  
Maximum penalty: \$4 000.
- (4) This regulation does not apply to vessels used in connection with the operations of prescribed vessels at the prescribed transshipment points.
- (5) In this regulation—

*prescribed transshipment point* means a transshipment point operated by OneSteel Manufacturing Pty Limited in Spencer Gulf at, or in the vicinity of, either of the following locations:

- (a) latitude 33°9.12'S, longitude 137°38.21'E (the *Cape Vessel Transshipment Point*);
- (b) latitude 33°6.12'S, longitude 137°38.30'E (the *Panamax Vessel Transshipment Point*);

*prescribed vessel* means—

- (a) in the case of the Cape Vessel Transshipment Point—a vessel of the class of vessels known as Cape-size vessels; or
- (b) in the case of the Panamax Vessel Transshipment Point—a vessel of the class of vessels known as Panamax-size vessels.

#### **Note—**

As required by section 10AA(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978*, the Minister has certified that, in the Minister's opinion, it is necessary or appropriate that these regulations come into operation as set out in these regulations.
