## WATERWORKS ACT 1932

*Temporary Variation to Water Restrictions—Port Augusta and Stirling North*

PURSUANT to section 33A of the Waterworks Act 1932, the South Australian Water Corporation (SA Water) with the approval of the Minister for Water Security varies the notice of Level 3 varied water restrictions imposed by notice dated 25 September 2007 (published in the *Government Gazette* on 27 September 2007) in respect of the application of that notice within:

- (i) that part of the City of Port Augusta located to the east of Spencer Gulf; and
- (ii) the township of Stirling North,

by:

- (iii) suspending the operation of the prohibition, restriction and regulation under that notice of purposes for which water supplied by SA Water may be used in relation to the purpose 'Gardens and Lawns' with effect from 12.01 a.m. on Saturday, 20 October 2007 until 11.59 p.m. on Sunday, 21 October 2007; and
- (iv) prohibiting, restricting and regulating the purposes for which water supplied to properties by SA Water may be used, and the times at which water may be used, in relation to the purpose 'Gardens and Lawns' as set out in the Schedule with effect from 12.01 a.m. on Saturday, 20 October 2007 until 11.59 p.m. on Sunday, 21 October 2007.

## SCHEDULE

**TEMPORARY VARIATION TO WATER RESTRICTIONS—PORT AUGUSTA AND STIRLING NORTH**

PURPOSE	WATER RESTRICTIONS
<b>GARDENS and LAWNS</b>	Watering cans and buckets may be used at any time to water outdoor trees, shrubs, plants and lawns. Hand-held hoses fitted with a trigger nozzle or drip-watering system may be used to water outdoor trees, shrubs, plants and lawns in accordance with the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Even numbered properties at any time between 12.01 a.m. on Saturday, 20 October 2007 until 11.59 p.m. on Saturday, 20 October 2007.</li> <li>• Odd numbered properties at any time between 12.01 a.m. on Sunday, 21 October 2007 until 11.59 p.m. on Sunday, 21 October 2007.</li> </ul> All sprinkler systems are prohibited for use in watering outdoor trees, shrubs, plants and lawns.
