BUILDING WORK CONTRACTORS ACT 1995

Exemption

- making an independent expert report available to prospective purchasers of the property; and
- giving prospective purchasers of the property notice of the absence of a policy of building indemnity insurance.

FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ACT 2007: SECTION 79

TAKE note that the notice made under Section 79 of the Fisheries Management Act 2007, published in the *South Australian Government Gazette*, dated 21 December 2010, referring to the West Coast Prawn Fishery, is hereby varied such that it will not be unlawful for a person fishing pursuant to a West Coast Prawn Fishery Licence to use prawn trawl nets in the waters specified in Schedule 1, under the conditions specified in Schedule 2, during the period specified in Schedule 3.

The waters of the West Coast Prawn Fishery adjacent to Venus Bay and Coffin Bay.

SCHEDULE 2

1. Each licence holder must ensure that a representative sample of the catch (a 'bucket count') is taken at least three times per night during the fishing activity.

2. Each 'bucket count' sample must be accurately weighed to 7 kg where possible and the total number of prawns contained in the bucket must be recorded on the daily catch and effort return.

3. Fishing must cease if one or both of the following limits are reached:

- (a) The average catch per vessel, per night (for all three vessels) drops below 300 kg for two consecutive nights;
- (b) The average prawn 'bucket count' for all three vessels exceeds 250 prawns per bucket on any single fishing night in the Venus Bay area or 240 prawns per bucket on any single fishing night in the Coffin Bay area.

4. The fleet must nominate a licence holder to provide a daily update by telephone or SMS message to the PIRSA Fisheries Manager, to report the average prawn catch per vessel and the average prawn 'bucket count' information.

5. No fishing activity may be undertaken between 0700 hours and 2030 hours on any day during the period of this notice

SOUTH AUSTRALIA**GAMING MACHINES ACT 1992**

GM Notice No. 1 of 2011
**Gaming Machines Advertising Code of Practice
Prescription Notice 2011**

[31 March 2010]

By this notice, the Independent Gambling Authority prescribes an advertising code of practice for the purposes of section 10A(1)(d) of the *Gaming Machines Act 1992*, as follows:

Gaming Machines Advertising Code of Practice

1. Purpose

This code provides a framework through which the holder of a gaming machine licence (“**gambling provider**”) can ensure that its advertising activities are consistent with the community’s expectations that the licensed business will be conducted in a responsible manner so as to minimise the harm caused by gambling.

2. General principle

A gambling provider must ensure that all gambling related advertising is undertaken in a manner that—

- (a) is socially responsible; and
- (b) does not mislead or deceive the customer.

2A. Intervention initiatives

- (1) During any period when a gambling provider is a party to, and is fully compliant with the terms of, an approved intervention agency agreement, the following provisions of this code do not apply to the gambling provider—
 - (a) clause 3(1B); and
 - (b) clause 3(1C); and
 - (c) clause 3(2)(k).

- (2) For the purposes of this code, a responsible gambling agreement is, in relation to a particular gambling provider—
- (a) an agreement made on or after the transition day—
 - (i) between the gambling provider and a body recognised for the purposes of section 10B(1)(a) of the *Gaming Machines Act 1992* (the “AIA”);
 - (ii) in the form prescribed for the purposes of section 10A(1)(f) of the *Gaming Machines Act 1992*; and
 - (iii) under which—
 - (A) the gambling provider provides the AIA, its employees and its agents with free and unrestricted access to the gambling provider’s premises, staff and patrons at all times the premises are open for business; and
 - (B) the gambling provider undertakes to its staff that they will in no way be the subject of prejudice or unfavourable treatment due to making reports of problem gambling behaviour or suspected problem gambling behaviour; and
 - (C) the gambling provider implements such smartcard or pre-commitment programs as are approved by the Authority and by the Minister for Gambling; and
 - (D) the gambling provider consents to, and facilitates, the comprehensive annual and periodic reporting to the Authority by the AIA of the AIA’s activities in respect of the gambling provider’s business.
 - (b) an agreement made before the transition day which was an approved intervention agency agreement within the meaning of clause 2A(2) of the advertising code of practice then adopted by the gambling provider in compliance with the licence condition then applying to the gambling provider by reason of paragraphs (na) and (nc) of Schedule 1 of the *Gaming Machines Act 1992*;
 - (c) an agreement made on or after the transition day novating an agreement referred to in paragraph (b) in terms not inconsistent with the form prescribed for the purposes of section 10A(1)(f) of the *Gaming Machines Act 1992*.

3. Specific provisions

- (1) A gambling provider must ensure that, when it advertises its gambling products, the advertising complies with—
- (a) applicable Commonwealth and State laws; and
 - (b) relevant advertising industry codes of practice—
- as in force from time to time.

- (1A) A gambling provider must ensure that, when it advertises its gambling products (other than on a permitted external sign), the advertising includes either—
- (a) the relevant expanded warning message; and
 - (b) if it is not reasonable or practicable to include the relevant expanded warning message, the condensed warning message.
- (1B) A gambling provider must ensure that there is no advertising of its gambling product on the exterior of its premises or in their immediate environs.
- (1C) A gambling provider must ensure that there is no advertising of its gambling product within its premises except for—
- (a) material in gambling areas within the premises; and
 - (b) directional signage in areas of the premises other than gambling areas.
- (2) A gambling provider must ensure that, when it advertises its gambling products, the advertising—
- (a) is not directed at minors;
 - (b) does not portray minors participating in gambling activities;
 - (c) is not explicitly or exclusively directed at vulnerable or disadvantaged groups (including recovering problem gamblers);
 - (d) does not promote gambling as a means of funding routine household purchases or costs of living (including mortgage repayments and rent, or education and clothing costs) or for relieving financial or personal difficulties;
 - (e) does not promote gambling as a means of enhancing social standing or employment, social or sexual prospects;

- (g) does not make claims related to winning or the prizes that can be won—
 - (i) that are not based on fact; or
 - (ii) that are unable to be proven; or
 - (iii) that are exaggerated;
- (h) does not state or imply that a player's skill can influence the outcome of a gambling activity;
- (i) does not associate gambling with excessive alcohol consumption;
- (j) does not exaggerate the connection between the gambling activity and the use to which the gambling provider's profits may be put; and
- (k) does not refer to factors that may induce a person to engage in gambling activity including, but not limited to, prizes or benefits other than those available on gaming machines.

- (3) A gambling provider must, when it advertises on radio or television, ensure that the advertising does not include sounds normally associated with the playing of gaming machines, including but not limited to—
- (a) the sound of coins landing in a coin tray;
 - (b) any sound made by a gaming machine when a prize is won.

4. Electronic media—time periods

A gambling provider must, in relation to advertising on radio or television, refrain from advertising its gambling products during the following periods:

- (a) for radio advertising, between 6.00am and 8.30am, Monday to Friday (both days inclusive);
- (b) for television advertising, between 4.00pm and 7.30pm, Monday to Friday (both days inclusive).

5. Prize advertising—specific obligations

- (1) If, when it advertises a gambling product, a gambling provider refers to, or relies on, the value or nature of one of the prizes which are available to be won (whether or not the prize is a prize of money) or the frequency with which the prize might be won, the advertising—
- (a) must include sufficient information to allow a reasonably informed person to understand the overall return to player or, if the product does not have an overall return to player, the odds of winning; and
 - (b) in addition, if the advertising is intended to encourage a person to gamble during a particular period, must include sufficient information to allow a reasonably informed person to appreciate how likely it is that the prize will be won by someone during that period.
- (2) If, in seeking to comply with this clause, a gambling provider—
- (a) calculates the theoretical number, value and frequency of prizes to be won;
 - (b) in the advertising or promotion, suggests an outcome no less favourable to the gambling provider than that theoretical outcome; and
 - (c) obtains an actual outcome more favourable than that which was advertised—

the gambling provider will still be regarded as complying with this clause.

- (3) Sub-clause (1)(a) does not apply to advertising of a trade promotion lottery offered in conjunction with the purchase of a gambling product if the odds or chance of winning the trade promotion lottery are dependent on factors beyond the control of the gambling provider.

6. Definitions and interpretation

(1) In this code—

“condensed warning message” means the following message—

“Gamble Responsibly.”;

“expanded warning message”—*see sub-clause (4) and Schedule 1;*

“gambling area” means a gaming area within the meaning of the *Gaming Machines Act 1992*;

“permitted external sign” means a sign—

- (a) affixed to the outside of a building containing a gambling area; or
- (b) affixed to the outside of a permanent structure, within the immediate environs of a building containing a gambling area, being a structure under the control of the relevant gambling provider—

which—

- (c) identifies the gambling provider; or
- (d) indicates the availability of a gambling activity inside the building;

“plug” means an announcement on radio or television which includes information about the relevant gambling provider’s gambling products or which associates one of the gambling provider’s gambling products with a particular program or period of programming;

“radio or television”—

- (a) means any kind of radio or television broadcasting service within the meaning given by the *Broadcasting Services Act 1992* (Commonwealth); but
- (b) does not include a radio or television broadcasting service principally operated for the purpose of promoting gambling products of the nature of those provided by a gambling provider, or related events—

and **“radio”** and **“television”** have corresponding meanings;

“relevant expanded warning message”—*see sub-clause (4) and Schedule 1;*

“transition day” means the day on which section 57(3) of the *Gaming Machines (Miscellaneous) Amendment Act 2010* comes into operation.

(2) For the purposes of this code, a gambling provider will be regarded as advertising—

- (a) if a provider of radio or television runs a plug in exchange for a payment or for some other form of valuable consideration (including an agreement to purchase advertising);

- (b) if a provider of radio or television, or a publisher, includes content in exchange for a payment or for some other form of valuable consideration (including an agreement to purchase advertising).
- (3) Advertising will be regarded as offending against clause 3(2)(g) if it contains material which includes one or more of the following expressions (or anything analogous to them)—
- (a) “Win”; and
- (b) “\$”—
- and that expression is not used in relation to—
- (c) a particular prize which has been determined or is payable; or
- (d) a reasonable approximation or estimate of a prize which can be won.
- (4) A message listed as an expanded warning message in the table in Schedule 1 is the relevant expanded warning message during—
- (a) the period of 6 months listed beside it as the first relevant period; and
- (b) the period of 6 months commencing on every third anniversary of the commencement of the first relevant period.

7. Operative dates and transitional

This code applies generally in respect of gambling operations conducted on or after the transition day.

GM Notice No. 2 of 2011
**Gaming Machines Responsible Gambling Code of
Practice Prescription Notice 2011**

[31 March 2010]

By this notice, the Independent Gambling Authority prescribes a responsible gambling code of practice for the purposes of section 10A(1)(e) of the *Gaming Machines Act 1992*, as follows:

**Gaming Machines Responsible Gambling Code of
Practice**

1. Purpose

This code provides a framework through which the holder of a gaming machine licence (“**gambling provider**”) can ensure that its general gambling practices are consistent with the community’s expectations that the licensed business will be conducted in a responsible manner so as to minimise the harm caused by gambling.

2. Venue responsible gambling documents

A gambling provider must—

(a) in each gambling area—

- (i) display prominently a message (whether alone or in combination with one or more other mandated messages) that gambling operations are governed by a code of practice; and
- (ii) ensure that a copy of this code is made available to people in the gambling area, on request; and

(b) for each gambling area, prepare and keep current a document detailing—

- (i) the manner in which staff training and measures for intervention with problem gamblers are implemented; and
- (ii) the roles of staff (described by name or by job title) in the implementation of this code.

2A. Intervention initiatives

- (1) During any period when a gambling provider is a party to, and is fully compliant with the terms of, a responsible gambling agreement, the following provisions of this code do not apply to the gambling provider—
 - (a) clause 4A; and
 - (b) clause 5A; and
 - (c) clause 6A(1)(b).
- (2) For the purposes of this code, a responsible gambling agreement is, in relation to a particular gambling provider—
 - (a) an agreement made on or after the transition day—
 - (i) between the gambling provider and a body recognised for the purposes of section 10B(1)(a) of the *Gaming Machines Act 1992* (the “AIA”);
 - (ii) in the form prescribed for the purposes of section 10A(1)(f) of the *Gaming Machines Act 1992*; and
 - (iii) under which—
 - (A) the gambling provider provides the AIA, its employees and its agents with free and unrestricted access to the gambling provider’s premises, staff and patrons at all times the premises are open for business; and
 - (B) the gambling provider undertakes to its staff that they will in no way be the subject of prejudice or unfavourable treatment due to making reports of problem gambling behaviour or suspected problem gambling behaviour; and
 - (C) the gambling provider implements such smartcard or pre-commitment programs as are approved by the Authority and by the Minister for Gambling; and
 - (D) the gambling provider consents to, and facilitates, the comprehensive annual and periodic reporting to the Authority by the AIA of the AIA’s activities in respect of the gambling provider’s business.
 - (b) an agreement made before the transition day which was an approved intervention agency agreement within the meaning of clause 2A(2) of the advertising code of practice then adopted by the gambling provider in compliance with the licence conditions then applying to the gambling provider by reason of paragraphs (nb) and (nc) of Schedule 1 of the *Gaming Machines Act 1992*;

- (c) an agreement made on or after the transition day novating an agreement referred to in paragraph (b) in terms not inconsistent with the form prescribed for the purposes of section 10A(1)(f) of the *Gaming Machines Act 1992*.
- (3) A gambling provider may arrange for its compliance with clause 5(3A) as part of a structured program of visitation by its AIA under a responsible gambling agreement.

3. Legislation and regulation

A gambling provider must—

- (a) conduct its business in accordance with all applicable laws and legal requirements; and
- (b) co-operate with regulatory bodies and government agencies in all matters, including their investigations of compliance with legal obligations.

4. Gambling areas

- (1) A gambling provider must ensure the prominent display on a gaming machine—
 - (a) on the cabinet of the gaming machine—of the condensed warning message and (or within) a helpline sticker; and
 - (b) if the gaming machine is capable of displaying a message on a second game screen in a manner approved by the Authority—of the relevant expanded warning message on that second screen;
- (2) A gambling provider must ensure that the time of day is prominently displayed throughout gambling areas.
- (3) A gambling provider must take all reasonable and practicable steps to ensure that a person plays no more than one gaming machine at a time, including the gambling provider giving a warning to a patron offending for the first time and, should such a warning not be heeded, asking the patron to leave the gaming room for 24 hours.

4A. Screening the sights and sounds of gambling

- (1) A gambling provider must ensure that, to the greatest extent practicable, it is not possible to see into a gambling area from within other parts of the premises or from outside the premises.
- (2) A gambling provider must ensure that, to the greatest extent practicable, sounds associated with gambling are not audible in parts of the premises other than gambling areas or in any area outside the premises.

5. Customer information and signage

- (1) A gambling provider must—
 - (a) prominently display responsible gambling materials (including a poster and a pamphlet) in gambling areas in a form which includes—
 - (i) the relevant expanded warning message; or
 - (ii) if it is not reasonable or practicable to include the relevant expanded warning message, the condensed warning message; and
 - (b) make available its responsible gambling poster and pamphlet in the following 5 languages other than english—
 - (i) arabic;
 - (ii) chinese;
 - (iii) greek;
 - (iv) italian;
 - (v) vietnamese—

together with any other language which the gambling provider considers appropriate.
- (2) A gambling provider must—
 - (a) ensure the prominent display of the condensed warning message and (or within) a helpline sticker on or near each ATM; and
 - (b) ensure that a quantity of helpline cards is available at or near each gaming machine, on or near each ATM and at other places throughout gambling areas.
- (3) A gambling provider must take all reasonable steps to ensure that a patron who demonstrates difficulty in controlling his or her personal expenditure on gambling products has his or her attention drawn to the name and telephone number of a widely available gambling referral service.
- (3A) A gambling provider must—
 - (a) identify a gambling rehabilitation agency that patrons can readily access (including the name of the manager of that agency and its address);
 - (b) ensure that staff are sufficiently informed about the identity of the gambling rehabilitation agency so as to be able to direct patrons to the agency;
 - (c) ensure that management level contact is established and maintained with the gambling rehabilitation agency about problem gambling matters.
- (4) A gambling provider must—
 - (a) from time to time file with the Authority; and

(b) to the greatest extent practicable, publish on its website (if it has one) a representation of—

the responsible gambling materials referred to in sub-clause (1).

- (5) A gambling provider must reinforce its responsible gambling policy in appropriate customer newsletters and other communications.
- (6) If a gambling provider is a member of a peak body, the gambling provider may comply with sub-clauses (4) and (5) through the activities of the peak body.

5A. Coin availability

- (1) A gambling provider must ensure that coin can only be obtained from—
- (a) a cashier; or
- (b) an automated coin dispensing machine which is located so as to enable patron activity to be monitored.
- (2) A gambling provider must ensure that patron activity on automated coin dispensing machines is routinely and regularly monitored.

6. Alcohol and gambling

- (1) A gambling provider must take all practicable steps—
- (a) to prevent a person from being allowed to gamble if—
- (i) the person is intoxicated; or
- (ii) the person's speech, balance, coordination or behaviour is noticeably impaired and it is reasonable to believe that the impairment is the result of the consumption of liquor.
- (b) to prevent the entry of a person into a gambling area, or a person remaining in a gambling area, if—
- (i) the person is intoxicated; or
- (ii) the person's speech, balance, coordination or behaviour is noticeably impaired and it is reasonable to believe that the impairment is the result of the consumption of liquor.
- (c) to ensure that liquor is not supplied to reward, promote or encourage continued gambling.
- (2) A gambling provider must ensure that a person is not served liquor while seated or standing at a gaming machine.

6A. Inducements

- (1) A gambling provider must not offer—
 - (a) any inducement (other than participation in an acceptable loyalty program) directed at encouraging patrons to gamble;
 - (b) participation in a loyalty program (other than an acceptable loyalty program which includes a pre-commitment program approved by the Authority).
- (2) This clause does not apply to the offering of an inducement offered in respect of a pre-commitment trial approved in writing by the Authority, within and subject to the terms of the instrument of approval.

7. Children

A gambling provider must establish and maintain a written procedure addressing the issue of young children (being children aged 10 years or less) who might, but for the procedure, be left unattended on the gambling provider's premises or in a motor vehicle parked in a car park over which the gambling provider has direct power and control.

8. Cheques

- (1) A gambling provider must not cash a cheque in a gambling area, unless the Authority has given an exemption from this prohibition to the gambling provider in respect of the gambling area by notice in writing stating the reason for the exemption (such as the location of the premises containing the gambling area).
- (2) A gambling provider must, if requested to provide a cheque in respect of an undisputed prize, winnings or redemption of credits in aggregate of \$1 000 or more, provide the cheque (subject to sub-clause (3)) as soon as practicable and, in any event, within 30 minutes after the patron makes the request and completes any formalities required by law.
- (3) The Authority must, if satisfied on application by a gambling provider that exceptional circumstances exist, fix a minimum period longer than 30 minutes for provision of a cheque under sub-clause (2).

8A. Internal reporting of problem gamblers

- (1) A gambling provider must establish a reporting process in respect of the identification of suspected problem gamblers by gaming staff and the recording of those gamblers' details.
- (2) The gambling provider must ensure that a gaming manager—
 - (a) reviews the record of suspected problem gamblers on a regular (at least fortnightly) basis; and
 - (b) documents, as part of the record, any steps taken to intervene in suspected problem gamblers' gambling behaviour.

9. Self-exclusion facility

- (1) A gambling provider must facilitate the indefinite voluntary exclusion of persons from one or more identified gambling areas.
- (2) A gambling provider must ensure that every approach by a person about self-exclusion is responded to while the person is on premises or on the telephone.
- (3) Self-exclusion will include—
 - (a) provision of a translation service (which may be a telephone interpreter service) during the application process, if requested;
 - (b) provision for immediate referral to, or liaison with, a counselling agency;
 - (c) provision for the review of self-exclusion notices with self-excluded persons before notices are rescinded;
 - (d) removal of self-excluded people from loyalty mailing databases.
- (4) A gambling provider must ensure, to the extent reasonably possible, that self-excluded persons are not allowed to enter, or remain in, gambling areas from which they have been excluded.

10. Staff and training

- (1) A gambling provider must—
 - (a) ensure that all approved gaming managers and all approved gaming employees receive problem gambling training—
 - (i) for all approved gaming employees—training which identifies problem gambling; and
 - (ii) for appropriate senior staff (including the person in charge of a gambling area)—advanced training on the identification of, and intervention techniques for, problem gambling, including administration of the self-exclusion process;
 - (b) maintain staff competency by—
 - (i) if the gambling provider is a member of a peak body and has access to on-going training and support by the peak body, ensuring that all gaming staff are kept up to date on responsible gambling initiatives and information provided by the peak body, and by conducting in-house training where necessary;
 - (ii) if the gambling provider does not have access to on-going training and support by a peak body or opts not to provide in-house training, providing formal refresher courses for all staff at least each 2 years;
 - (c) include responsible gambling information in employee newsletters and magazines; and
 - (d) display responsible gambling material in back of house areas to remind staff of policies and their responsibilities.

- (2) If a gambling provider uses an external provider for training, that training provider must be appropriately accredited in a manner acceptable to the Authority.
- (3) Problem gambling training programs will be designed to—
 - (a) provide information about the potential effect of gambling on customers; and
 - (b) include information on the recognition and identification of problem gambling traits; and
 - (c) ensure that the processes for approach, intervention, referral and follow-up are clear and well understood.
- (4) A gambling provider must ensure that problem gambling training programs are regularly reviewed and revised.
- (5) A gambling provider must—
 - (a) make arrangements to ensure that training programs provided to its staff are the subject of an annual audit of their compliance with the requirements of this code; and
 - (b) provide a report of the outcome of each audit to the Authority within 28 days after completion.
- (6) A gambling provider must take reasonable steps to ensure that staff with a potential or actual gambling problem are identified and referred for treatment.
- (7) If a gambling provider provides training through an appropriately accredited external provider, the gambling provider may comply with sub-clauses (3), (4) and (5) through the activities of that external provider.
- (8) If a gambling provider is a member of a peak body or has access to on-going training and support by a peak body, the gambling provider may comply with sub-clauses (3), (4) and (5) through the activities of the peak body.

11. Definitions and interpretation

- (1) In this code—

“acceptable loyalty program” means—

- (a) a structured program, with published terms and conditions, which provides rewards in respect of gambling activity which relate directly to the activity or to particular levels of gambling activity; or
- (b) a program which has been specifically approved by the Authority;

“ATM” includes—

- (a) an automatic teller machine in or near premises containing a gambling area;

(b) an electronic funds transfer device in or near premises containing a gambling area—

over which the relevant gambling provider could reasonably be expected to exercise control;

“condensed warning message” means the following message—

“Gamble Responsibly.”;

“expanded warning message”—see sub-clause (2) and Schedule 1;

“gambling area” means a gaming area within the meaning of the *Gaming Machines Act 1992*;

“helpline card” means a card of approximately 9 cm by 5 cm giving the name and telephone number of a widely available gambling referral service, identified by its usual name;

“helpline sticker” means a sticker giving the name and telephone number of a widely available gambling referral service, identified by its usual name;

“peak body” means a genuine association formed to protect or promote the interests of a section of the gambling industry;

“relevant expanded warning message”—see sub-clause (2) and Schedule 1;

“transition day” means the day on which section 57(3) of the *Gaming Machines (Miscellaneous) Amendment Act 2010* comes into operation.

- (2) A message listed as an expanded warning message in the table in Schedule 1 is the relevant expanded warning message during—
- (a) the period of 6 months listed beside it as the first relevant period; and
 - (b) the period of 6 months commencing on every third anniversary of the commencement of the first relevant period.

12. Operative dates and transitional

- (1) This code applies generally in respect of gambling operations conducted on or after the transition day.
- (2) Despite sub-clause (1), in respect of the obligation set out in clause 4A [screening the sights and sounds of gaming]—
 - (a) a gambling provider will not be required to comply with the obligation until 1 December 2011; and

- (b) if a gambling provider has never been, in the period prior to 1 December 2011, a party to a responsible gambling agreement, the gambling provider must be able to show that it has identified a course of action to be in compliance when required and that it is taking reasonable steps to follow that course of action;
- (c) if a gambling provider which has been a party to a responsible gambling agreement ceases to be a party to the agreement, the gambling provider—
- (i) must, upon that cessation, identify a course of action to be in compliance within 6 months after cessation; and
 - (ii) is not required to be in compliance until 6 months after that cessation.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1961

Pursuant to Section 161A and 163AA of the Road Traffic Act 1961

**EXEMPTION FOR SINGLE AXLE PIG TRAILERS TO EXCEED
THE MAXIMUM MASS LIMIT OF 8.5 TONNES****Information Note**

DTEI has previously commissioned a study by ARRB Transport Research Ltd to examine the safety, pavement, stability and drawbar effects of the increased mass on pig trailers. The report identified a number of deficiencies in the design of these trailers and in light of these issues and road safety, all pig trailer weights will revert back to those listed in the South Australian *Road Traffic (Mass and Loading) Regulations 1999*.

DTEI will make the research and information completed to date available to interested members of the industry who may wish to progress further assessment of these vehicles through the Performance Based Standards (PBS) Scheme.

To assist industry with this transition this *Gazette* Notice will provide for operation at the pre-December 1999 mass limit for three years, after which time single axle pig trailers will revert to the mass limit of 8.5 tonnes as prescribed in the South Australian *Road Traffic (Mass and Loading) Regulations 1999*.

1. REVOCATION OF PREVIOUS NOTICE

DTEI has previously commissioned a study by ARRB Transport Research Ltd to examine the safety, pavement, stability and drawbar effects of the increased mass on pig trailers. The report identified a number of deficiencies in the design of these trailers and in light of these issues and road safety, all pig trailer weights will revert back to those listed in the South Australian *Road Traffic (Mass and Loading) Regulations 1999*.

DTEI will make the research and information completed to date available to interested members of the industry who may wish to progress further assessment of these vehicles through the Performance Based Standards (PBS) Scheme.

To assist industry with this transition this Gazette Notice will provide for operation at the pre-December 1999 mass limit for three years, after which time tandem axle pig trailers will revert to the mass limit of 15 tonnes as prescribed in the South Australian *Road Traffic (Mass and Loading) Regulations 1999*.

1. REVOCATION OF PREVIOUS NOTICE

The Notice titled '*Exemption for Tandem Axle Pig Trailers to Exceed the Maximum Mass Limit of 15 tonnes*' published in the *Government Gazette* dated 18 March 2010, is hereby revoked.

3.5 The mass carried on the Pig Trailer must not exceed the lesser of:

3.5.1 The manufacturer's specified Aggregate Trailer Mass;

3.5.2 The manufacturer's specified Gross Trailer Mass;

3.5.3 The Gross Trailer Mass specified by an Australian Authority; or

3.5.4 16.5 tonnes.
