DEVELOPMENT ACT 1993

Alteration to the Building Code of Australia

Preamble

1. The Building Code of Australia being Volumes One and Two in the National Construction Code series as in force from time to time is adopted by the Development Regulations 2008, as part of the Building Rules under the Development Act 1993.

2. The Building Code of Australia is altered annually for national adoption on 1 May each year.

3. The Development Act 1993 requires that notice of the alteration must be published before the alteration can take effect.

NOTICE

PURSUANT to Section 4 (7) of the Development Act 1993, notice is given of an alteration to the 2014 edition of the Building Code of Australia being Volumes One and Two in the National Construction Code series. The Code has been amended and republished as BCA 2015 by the Australian Building Codes Board.

BCA 2015, as modified by the variations and additions for South Australia contained in the Appendix to that Code, will take effect for the purposes of the Development Act 1993 on 1 May 2015, with the following alteration:

- (a) SA Table 1 and SA H3.2 of Volume One—Minister's Specification SA H3.2 Concessions and additional requirements for farm buildings (dated 2004) is replaced with Minister's Specification SA H3.2 Concessions for farm buildings (dated 2015).

DEVELOPMENT ACT 1993, SECTION 29

AMENDMENT TO THE CLEVE COUNCIL DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Preamble

It is necessary to amend the Cleve Council Development Plan (the Plan) dated 26 April 2013 to address an inconsistency in the Plan.

NOTICE

PURSUANT to Section 29 (2) (b) (i) of the Development Act 1993, I:

1. Amend the Plan as follows:

(a) within the Primary Production Zone:

(i) insert the following text as Objective 5 and consecutively renumber the existing Objective 5 to Objective 6:

‘Protection of rural support infrastructure for the bulk handling and transportation of farm commodities situated at Mangalo.’

(ii) insert the following text after the last paragraph in the Desired Character section:

‘Heggaton and Mangalo

Development within the Hundred of Heggaton and the Hundred of Mangalo will include a range of different types of farming activities, as well as appropriate value-adding uses. Large allotments of greater than 40 hectares in size will be maintained to prevent the reduced viability of primary production and to protect the scenic quality of the rural landscape. Development (including land division) will not lead to a reduction in the ability of land within these areas to be used for primary production purposes and will not result in the establishment of rural-residential land-uses.

New buildings will generally be associated with existing clusters of buildings and will be of complementary scale and mass, while also being of appropriate dimensions to serve their intended function. New dwellings will generally be single storey and will include pitched roofs, verandas and porches to address climatic issues. Isolated new buildings, including large sheds, will be located and designed to blend with the existing landscape, with appropriate earthworks and building design to suit the natural landform. Other structures will be of a form that blends with, and does not detract from, the scenic qualities and function of the primary production area.

The open rural landscape is the dominant character element and new development will maintain that character, with new buildings appropriately sited, designed and screened by vegetation. New buildings will be constructed using materials and colours that blend with the rural landscape and are traditionally used within the rural environment including corrugated steel, stone and timber.’

(iii) replace Principle of Development Control 11 with:

‘Land outside of the Hundred of Heggaton and the Hundred of Mangalo should only be divided if one or more of the following apply:

(a) no additional allotments are created

(b) an owner of land wishes to create a separate allotment of not greater than 5 hectare in area to contain one of two habitable houses on the land, each of which was built or under construction before 30 June 2002

(c) the land division is to facilitate horticulture, floriculture, agriculture, animal keeping, or land based aquaculture.’

(iv) INSERT new Principle of Development Control 12:

‘Land division within the Hundred of Heggaton or the Hundred of Mangalo areas should only occur under one of the following circumstances, where:

(a) no additional allotments of less than 40 hectares are created

(b) an owner of land wishes to create a separate allotment of not greater than 5 hectares to contain one of two existing dwellings on the land, each of which was built or under construction before 29 August 1985

(c) one additional allotment of 5 hectares or less in an area is being excised from the land held in a Certificate of Title existing prior to 29 August 1985, where the allotment is to provide a separate title for the erection of a dwelling for a relative of the registered proprietor of the subject land, or a person being in employment on the land.’

(v) replace the Complying Development Compliance Criteria / Conditions with the following:

‘Provided:

(a) all buildings are set back 50 m or more from the existing road boundary

(b) within the Hundred of Heggaton or the Hundred of Mangalo, the building’s external materials, cladding and roofing are not:

(i) damaged in any way

(ii) punctured

(iii) rusted

(iv) stained

(v) weathered.’

- (vi) within the non-complying table, insert the following Forms of Development and exceptions in alphabetical order:

Form of Development	Exceptions
Bank within the Hundred of Heggaton or the Hundred of Mangalo	
Horticulture involving the growing of olives within the Hundred of Heggaton or the Hundred of Mangalo	Except where the location for the growing of olives achieves (a) and (b): (a) at least 500 m from all of the following: (i) a National Park (ii) a Conservation Park (iii) a Wilderness Protection Area (iv) the edge of a substantially intact stratum of native vegetation greater than 5 hectares in area (b) 50 m from the edge of a substantially intact stratum of native vegetation 5 hectares or less in area.
Motor showroom within the Hundred of Heggaton or the Hundred of Mangalo	
Warehouse within the Hundred of Heggaton or the Hundred of Mangalo	

- (vii) Within the non-complying table replace the exceptions for Form of Development land division with the following:


Form of Development	Exceptions
Land Division	Except: (a) outside of the Hundreds of Heggaton or Mangalo, where: (i) the division creates an additional allotment greater than 40 hectares (ii) the division involves boundary rationalisation, where the number of resulting allotments is not more than the number that existed prior to rationalisation (iii) an allotment no greater than 5 hectares is to be created to contain one of two habitable houses on the land, each of which was built or under construction before 30 June 2002 (b) within the Hundred of Heggaton or Hundred of Mangalo, where one of the following circumstances applies: (i) no additional allotments of less than 40 hectares are created (ii) an owner of land wishes to create a separate allotment of 5 hectares or less to contain one of two existing dwellings on the land, each of which was built or under construction before 29 August 1985 (iii) one additional allotment of 5 hectares or less in an area is being excised from the land held in a Certificate of Title existing prior to 29 August 1985, where the allotment is to provide a separate title for the erection of a dwelling for a relative of the registered proprietor of the subject land.


- (viii) Within the Public Notification category 2 listing, insert the following form of development in alphabetical order:

- 'Bulk commodity handling and storage facility within within the Hundred of Heggaton or the Hundred of Mangalo.'

- (b) replace Council Preface Map, Council Index Map, Location Map Cle/1, Overlay Map Cle/1—Transport, Overlay Map Cle/1—Development Constraints, Overlay Map FrH/1—Heritage and Zone Map Cle/1 with the contents of 'ATTACHMENT A'.



Council Index Map



FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ACT 2007: SECTION 79

TAKE note that the notice made under Section 79 of the Fisheries Management Act 2007, dated 12 January 2015, and published in the *South Australian Government Gazette* dated 15 January 2015, on page 280, being the first notice on that page, referring to the Spencer Gulf Prawn Fishery, is hereby varied such that it will not be unlawful for a person fishing pursuant to a Spencer Gulf Prawn Fishery Licence to use prawn trawl nets in the areas specified in Schedule 1, during the period specified in Schedule 2, and under the conditions specified in Schedule 3.

SCHEDULE 1

1. The waters of the Spencer Gulf Prawn Fishery that are:

South of the following co-ordinates:

Latitude 33°34.00'S, longitude 137°14.00'E, then to position latitude 33°34.00'S, longitude 137°34.00'E, then to position latitude 33°38.00'S, longitude 137°34.00'E, then to position latitude 33°46.00'S, longitude 137°44.00'E.

2. Except the waters contained within and bounded by the following co-ordinates, which shall remain closed to fishing:

(a) The area known as the Southern Closure:

Latitude 33° 41.00 S, longitude 137° 06.00 E, then to position latitude 33°52.00'S, longitude 137°15.00'E, then to position latitude 33°54.00'S, longitude 137°09.00'E, then to position latitude 33°59.00'S, longitude 137°12.00'E, then to position latitude 34°14.00'S, longitude 136°57.00'E, then to position latitude 34°14.00'S, longitude 136°52.00'E, then to position latitude 34°18.00'S, longitude 136°49.00'E, then to position latitude 34°18.00'S, longitude 136°42.00'E, then to position latitude 34°07.00'S, longitude 136°48.00'E, then to position latitude 33°55.00'S, longitude 136°34.00'E.

(b) the area known as the 'Wardang Closure':

Latitude 34°10.00'S, longitude 137°28.00'E, then to position latitude 34°21.00'S, longitude 137°12.00'E, then to position latitude 34°45.00'S, longitude 137°15.00'E, then to position latitude 34°48.53'S, longitude 137°09.45'E, then to position latitude 34°48.53'S, longitude 137°06.00'E, then to position latitude 34°50.75'S, longitude 137°06.00'E, then to position latitude 34°54.00'S, longitude 137°01.00'E.

SCHEDULE 2

Commencing at sunset on 20 April 2015 and end at sunrise on 29 April 2015.

SCHEDULE 3

1. The co-ordinates in Schedule 1 are defined as degrees, decimal minutes and based on the World Geodetic System 1984 (WGS 84).

2. No fishing activity may be undertaken between the prescribed times of sunrise and sunset for Adelaide (as published in the *South Australian Government Gazette* pursuant to the requirements of the Proof of Sunrise and Sunset Act 1923) during the period specified in Schedule 2.

3. Fishing must cease:

(a) in the fishing area known as the 'Mid/North Gulf' area (as described in the Management Plan for the South Australian Commercial Spencer Gulf Prawn Fishery October 2014) if the average catch per vessel, per night (for all vessels) drops below 500 kg; and

(b) after the Mid/North Gulf area is closed; in the fishing area known as the 'Southern Gulf' area (as described in the Management Plan for the South Australian Commercial Spencer Gulf Prawn Fishery October 2014) if the average catch per vessel over two consecutive nights falls below 350 kg.

4. Fishing must cease:

(a) in an area in the Mid/North Gulf if the average prawn bucket count for all vessels exceeds 260 prawns per 7 kg; and

(b) after the Mid/North Gulf area is closed; in an area in the Southern Gulf if the average prawn bucket count for all vessels exceeds 260 prawns per 7 kg.

5. No fishing activity may occur without the authorisation of Co-ordinator at Sea, Greg Palmer, or other nominated Co-ordinator at Sea appointed by the Spencer Gulf and West Coast Prawn Fishermen's Association.

6. The authorisation of the Co-ordinator at Sea must be in writing, signed and record the day, date and permitted fishing area within the waters of Schedule 1 in the form of a notice sent to the fishing fleet or vary an earlier authorisation issued by the Co-ordinator at Sea.

7. The Co-ordinator at Sea must cause a copy of any authorisation for fishing activity or variation of same, made under this notice to be emailed to the Prawn Fisheries Manager immediately after it is made.

8. The Co-ordinator at Sea must keep records of all authorisations issued pursuant to this notice.

FISHERIES MANAGEMENT ACT 2007: SECTION 115

TAKE notice that pursuant to Section 115 of the Fisheries Management Act 2007, the holder of Western Zone Abalone Fishery licence issued pursuant to the Fisheries Management (Abalone Fisheries) Regulations 2006 (the 'exemption holders') or their registered master are exempt from the provisions of Part 2, Clause 5 of Schedule 2 and Clause 118 of Schedule 6 of the Fisheries Management (General) Regulations 2007 in that the exemption holder shall not be guilty of an offence when taking Roe's abalone (*Haliotis roei*) that is undersize, from the waters of the Western Zone, as defined in the Fisheries Management (Abalone Fisheries) Regulations 2006 (the exempted activity) subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1 from 14 April 2015 to 31 December 2015, unless varied or revoked earlier.

SCHEDULE 1

1. While engaged in the exempted activity, the exemption holders may only take Roe's abalone (*Haliotis roei*) provided that it is not less than 75 mm in shell length. All Roe's abalone (*Haliotis roei*) must be landed in shell.

2. The exempted activity may not occur within any aquatic reserve or any sanctuary zone established under the Marine Parks Act 2007.

3. Upon completion of the day's fishing activities the exemption holders shall each complete the Roei Daily Catch and Effort Return Form provided by the South Australian Research and Development Institute (SARDI). The completed Roei Daily Catch and Effort Return Forms must be returned to SARDI within 15 days of the end of the month to which it relates. Exemption No. ME9902761.

4. The catch of Roe's abalone (*Haliotis roei*) is to be stored separately from other species of taken abalone in an approved bag or bin and the estimated whole weight must be recorded on Part A of the CDR1 form.

5. All Roe's abalone (*Haliotis roei*) taken pursuant to this notice shall be delivered to one of the registered fish processors listed in Schedule 2 of this notice for weighing, within 48 hours of landing, within the State of South Australia.

6. The exemption holders shall not, during the period of this notice, take a combined total quantity of Roe's abalone (*Haliotis roei*) that exceeds 500 kg each (whole weight).

7. The exemption holders shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Management Act 2007, or any regulations made under that Act except where specifically exempted by this notice.

8. While engaged in the exempted activity the exemption holders must have in his possession a copy of this notice and produce a copy of the notice if required by a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer. Exemption No. ME9902761.

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Primary Produce (Food Safety Schemes) (Dairy Industry) Variation Regulations 2015*.

2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

Part 2—Variation of *Primary Produce (Food Safety Schemes) (Dairy Industry) Regulations 2005*

4—Variation of regulation 3—Interpretation

- (1) Regulation 3(1), definitions of *dairy primary production business* and *dairy processing business*—delete the definitions and substitute:

dairy primary production business means a business, or an enterprise or activity carried on for a commercial purpose, that involves the production of milk for human consumption and includes the keeping, grazing, feeding and milking of animals and the storage of milk on the premises at which the animals were milked;

dairy processing business means a business, or an enterprise or activity carried on for a commercial purpose, that involves the manufacture of dairy products;

- (2) Regulation 3(1), definition of *dairy transport business*—delete the definition and substitute:

dairy products means—

- (a) milk (as defined in these regulations); and
- (b) any other product included in the definition of *dairy product* in Standard 4.2.4 of the *Food Standards Code*;

dairy transport business means a business, or an enterprise or activity carried on for a commercial purpose, involving the collection and transport of milk from a dairy primary production business to a dairy processing business or the transport of bulk milk or dairy products between dairy processors;

- (3) Regulation 3(1), definition of *milk*—delete the definition and substitute:

milk means milk (including colostrum) derived from a cow, goat, sheep or buffalo;

5—Substitution of regulation 18

Regulation 18—delete the regulation and substitute:

18—Compliance with Standard 4.2.4 of Food Standards Code

- (1) In this regulation, a reference to Standard 4.2.4 of the *Food Standards Code* is a reference to that Standard as modified by subregulation (4).
- (2) An accredited producer must ensure that the activities under the accreditation are carried on in compliance with the provisions of Standard 4.2.4 of the *Food Standards Code* applicable to those activities.
- (3) The Authority may, on application, exempt an accredited producer from compliance with specified provisions of Standard 4.2.4 of the *Food Standards Code* if satisfied that satisfactory alternative arrangements have been made by the producer or in order to allow the producer a specified period within which to comply.
- (4) Standard 4.2.4 of the *Food Standards Code* is modified as follows:
 - (a) a reference to a dairy primary production business is to be taken to be a reference to a dairy primary production business as defined in these regulations;
 - (b) a reference to a dairy processing business is to be taken to be a reference to a dairy processing business as defined in these regulations;
 - (c) a reference to dairy products is to be taken to be a reference to dairy products as defined in these regulations;
 - (d) a reference to a dairy transport business is to be taken to be a reference to a dairy transport business as defined in these regulations;
 - (e) a reference to milk is to be taken to be a reference to milk as defined in these regulations.

Note—

As required by section 10AA(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978*, the Minister has certified that, in the Minister's opinion, it is necessary or appropriate that these regulations come into operation as set out in these regulations.
