ESSENTIAL SERVICES ACT 1981

*Ministerial Direction in Relation to Operation of the National
Electricity Market (NEM) in the South Australian NEM Region*

Preamble

1. A period of emergency has been proclaimed under the Essential Services Act 1981.

2. The period of emergency applies in respect of the following essential services ('proclaimed essential services'):

- The production, distribution or supply of electricity.

NOTICE

PURSUANT to Section 4 of the Essential Services Act 1981, being of opinion that it is in the public interest to do so, I give the following direction in relation to the provision or use of proclaimed essential services:

The Australian Energy Market Operator (AEMO) is directed to take all reasonable actions, utilising a best endeavours approach, to maintain the expected Rate of Change of Frequency (RoCoF) of the South Australian power system, in relation to the non-credible coincident trip of both circuits of the Heywood Interconnector when the power system is in a secure operating state, at or below 3Hz per second.
