SECTION 68

Approval of Category B Containers

I, ANDREA KAYE WOODS, Team Leader, Container Deposit Legislation and Delegate of the Environment Protection Authority ('the Authority'), pursuant to section 68 of the Environment Protection Act, 1993 (SA) ('the Act') hereby:

Approval of Category B Containers:

Approve as Category B Containers, subject to the conditions in subclauses 1, 2, 3 and 4 below, each of the classes of containers identified by reference to the following matters described in the first 4 columns of Schedule 1 of this Notice which are sold in South Australia:

- (a) the product which each class of containers shall contain;
- (b) the size of the containers;
- (c) the type of containers;
- (d) the name of the holders of these approvals.

1. That containers of the class to which the approval relates must bear the refund marking specified by the Authority for containers of that class. The Authority specifies the following refund markings for Category B containers:
 - (1) "10c refund at collection depots when sold in SA",
 - Or
 - (2) "10c refund at SA/NT collection depots in State/Territory of purchase"
2. The holder of the approval must have in place an effective and appropriate waste management arrangement in relation to containers of that class. For the purpose of this approval notice the company named in column 5 of Schedule 1 of this Notice is the nominated super collector.
3. In the case of an approval in relation to category B containers that the waste management arrangement must require the holder of the approval to provide specified super collectors with a declaration in the form determined by the Authority in relation to each sale of such containers by the holder of the approval as soon as practicable after the sale";
4. The holder of these approvals must ensure that if a sticker bearing the refund marking has been approved, and is applied to the container, then the sticker must not be placed on any portion of the opening mechanism or in any other place that would require complete or partial removal of the sticker before the contents may be consumed.

ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION ACT 1993

SECTION 69

Variation to Existing Approval of Collection Depot

I, ANDREA KAYE WOODS, Delegate of the Environment Protection Authority ('the Authority'), pursuant to section 69 of the Environment Protection Act, 1993 (SA) ('the Act') hereby:

1. Variation to Existing Approval of Collection Depot:

Vary the approval of the collection depot listed at Schedule 1 of this notice, that was granted under the Act prior to the date of this Notice and impose the conditions of this approval to be as follows:

1.1 Approval of Collection Depot:

The collection depot identified by reference to the following matters is approved:

- the name of the collection depot described in column 1 of Schedule 1 of this Notice;
- the name of the company identified in column 2 of Schedule 1 of this notice;
- the name of the proprietor of the depot identified in column 3 of Schedule 1 of this Notice;
- the location of the depot described in columns 4-7 of Schedule 1 of this Notice.

The collection depot listed at Schedule 1 of this Notice is approved in relation to all classes of containers, which were approved under the Act, at or subsequent to the date of this Notice, as Category B Containers.

1.2 Conditions of approval:

Impose the following conditions on the approval:

- If the Approval Holder's name or postal address (or both) changes, then the Approval Holder must inform the Authority in writing, within 28 days of the change occurring.
- If the collection depot is sold to another party, the Approval Holder must inform the Authority in writing, within 28 days of settlement.
- The Approval Holder who wishes to cease operation of the depot shall notify the Authority in writing no less than 14 days from the date of closing.
- The Approval Holder, or a person acting on his or her behalf, must not pay a refund on, or seek reimbursement for, containers that the Approval Holder, or the person acting on his or her behalf, knows were not purchased in South Australia.
- The Approval Holder must ensure that prominent signage is displayed, detailing the offence and the penalties under Section 69 the Act, for presenting interstate containers for refund.





 - (iii) the only cannabinoids in or on the seeds are naturally present; and
 - (iv) if the seeds are a food for retail sale or used as an ingredient in a food for retail sale—the seeds are non-viable and hulled;
- (b) hemp seed oil that is extracted from seeds of low THC cannabis if the oil contains not more than 10 mg/kg of total tetrahydrocannabinols and the only cannabinoids in the oil are those that were naturally present in or on the seeds from which the oil was extracted;
- (c) a beverage that is derived from seeds of low THC cannabis if the beverage contains not more than 0.2 mg/kg of total tetrahydrocannabinols and the only cannabinoids in the beverage are those that were naturally present in or on the seeds from which the beverage was derived;
- (d) any other product that is extracted or derived from seeds of low THC cannabis if the product contains not more than 5 mg/kg of total tetrahydrocannabinols and the only cannabinoids in the product are those that were naturally present in or on the seeds from which the product was extracted or derived;

prescribed industrial hemp authority means—

- (a) the holder of a licence under the *Industrial Hemp Act 2017*; or
- (b) an inspector authorised under the *Industrial Hemp Act 2017*; or
- (c) a supplier of certified hemp seeds; or
- (d) a supplier of industrial hemp; or
- (e) a person employed at a laboratory or place approved for examination and testing under section 19(1)(e) of the *Industrial Hemp Act 2017*;

seed includes part of a seed;

Uniform Poisons Standard means the current Poisons Standard as defined in the Commonwealth Act (as in force from time to time).

 - (b) the possession or supply of processed hemp fibre containing 0.1% or less of tetrahydrocannabinols (including hemp fibre products manufactured from such fibre); or
 - (c) the possession or supply of hemp seed oil containing cannabinoids at a level not exceeding 50 mg/kg for purposes other than internal human use; or
 - (d) the possession or supply of industrial hemp in the course of the person's employment at a laboratory or place approved for examination and testing under section 19(1)(e) of the *Industrial Hemp Act 2017*.
- (2) A person employed or engaged by a prescribed industrial hemp authority to transport industrial hemp to another industrial hemp authority is exempt from the application of section 33I(2) of the Act in respect of the possession and supply of industrial hemp for the purpose of such transport.

8A—Exemption—section 33L(2)

- (1) A person is exempt from the application of section 33L(2) of the Act in respect of—
- (a) the possession or consumption of a low THC cannabis food product; or
 - (b) the possession of processed hemp fibre containing 0.1% or less of tetrahydrocannabinols (including hemp fibre products manufactured from such fibre); or
 - (c) the possession of hemp seed oil containing cannabinoids at a level not exceeding 50 mg/kg for purposes other than internal human use; or
 - (d) the possession of industrial hemp in the course of the person's employment at a laboratory or place approved for examination and testing under section 19(1)(e) of the *Industrial Hemp Act 2017*.
- (2) A person employed or engaged by a prescribed industrial hemp authority to transport industrial hemp to another industrial hemp authority is exempt from the application of section 33L(2) of the Act in respect of the possession of industrial hemp for the purpose of such transport.

 - (j) flubromazepam;
 - (k) flubromazolam;

Part 1—Preliminary

1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Mutual Recognition (South Australia) (Controlled Substances) Variation Regulations 2017*.

2—Commencement

These regulations will come into operation on 12 November 2017.

3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

Part 2—Variation of *Mutual Recognition (South Australia) (Controlled Substances) Regulations 2015*

4—Insertion of regulation 6

After regulation 5 insert:

6—Temporary exemption—certain controlled drugs

- (1) For the purposes of section 5 of the Act and section 15 of the Commonwealth Act—

- (a) the substances to which this regulation applies and any preparation containing 1 or more of those substances are declared to be goods to which section 15 of the Commonwealth Act applies; and
 - (b) the provisions of the *Controlled Substances (Controlled Drugs, Precursors and Plants) Regulations 2014* referring to a substance to which this regulation applies (inserted by the *Controlled Substances (Controlled Drugs, Precursors and Plants) (Miscellaneous) Variation Regulations 2017*) are declared to be a law to which section 15 of the Commonwealth Act applies.
- (2) The exemptions from the Commonwealth Act under subregulation (1) have effect for a period of 12 months following the commencement of this regulation.
- (3) This regulation applies to the following substances:
 - (a) acetyl fentanyl;
 - (b) butyryl fentanyl;
 - (c) clonazepam;
 - (d) deschloroetizolam;
 - (e) N,N-Dialkylaminocyclohexyl alkyl benzamides (not otherwise listed in Schedule 1 of the *Controlled Substances (Controlled Drugs, Precursors and Plants) Regulations 2014*);
 - (f) N,N-Dialkylaminocyclohexylmethyl alkyl benzamides (not otherwise listed in Schedule 1 of the *Controlled Substances (Controlled Drugs, Precursors and Plants) Regulations 2014*);
 - (g) 3,4-dichloro-N-[2-(dimethylamino)cyclohexyl]-N-methylbenzamide (U-47700);
 - (h) diclazepam;
 - (i) fentanyls (not otherwise listed in Schedule 1 of the *Controlled Substances (Controlled Drugs, Precursors and Plants) Regulations 2014*);
 - (j) flubromazepam;
 - (k) flubromazolam;
 - (l) furanyl fentanyl;
 - (m) meclonazepam;
 - (n) nifoxipam;
 - (o) ofentanil;
 - (p) para-fluorobutyryl-fentanyl;
 - (q) pyrazolam.
