AUTHORISED BETTING OPERATIONS ACT 2000

GR NOTICE NO. 3 OF 2019

Section 4(1)(a)

*Approved Contingencies (Oodnadatta Racing & Horse Sports Inc.—Gallopings) Notice 2019*

I, Dini Soulio, Liquor and Gambling Commissioner, by this notice, approve contingencies relating to sporting or other events within Australia:

**1. Citation**

This notice may be cited as the Approved Contingencies (Oodnadatta Racing & Horse Sports Inc. Races—Gallopings) Notice 2019.

**2. Approval**

- (1) The contingencies listed in the table are approved in respect of fixed odds betting by licensed bookmakers.
- (2) This approval is subject to the provisions of the *Authorised Betting Operations Act 2000*, the Bookmakers Licensing Rules 2000, any other rules made under section 62 of the Act, and the conditions to which a licence or permit are subject.
- (3) This approval of contingencies may be amended or revoked by further notice.

**3. Definitions**

In this Notice—

“**Event**”—

- (a) means a race on the flat for horses where each animal is ridden by a person;
- (b) includes, in relation to an event mentioned in paragraph (a) for which there were more accepters than places, a division of that event offering the same prize as the event;

“**place**” means the contingency that a specified Entrant will place either first or second (or, if applicable, third or fourth) in a specified Event (including where different odds are offered by a bookmaker for first place *vis-a-vis* any of second or, if applicable, third or fourth place);

“**race**”, with respect to horses, includes—

- (a) a race conducted by a licensed racing club; and
- (b) a race at a picnic race meeting or a gymkhana;

“**win**” means the contingency that a specified Entrant will place first in, or win, a specified Event.

BUILDING WORK CONTRACTORS ACT 1995

*Exemption*

## SCHEDULE 3

1. This exemption is limited to domestic building work personally performed by the licensee in relation to the building work described in Schedule 2.
2. This exemption does not apply to any domestic building work the licensee contracts to another building work contractor, for which that contractor is required by law to hold building indemnity insurance.
3. That the licensee does not transfer his interest in the land prior to five years from the date of completion of the building work the subject of this exemption, without the prior authorisation of Consumer and Business Services (CBS). Before giving such authorisation, CBS may require the licensee to take any reasonable steps to protect the future purchaser(s) of the property, including but not limited to:
  - Providing evidence that an adequate policy of building indemnity insurance is in force to cover the balance of the five-year period from the date of completion of the building work the subject of this exemption;
  - Providing evidence of an independent expert inspection of the building work the subject of this exemption;
  - Making an independent expert report available to prospective purchasers of the property;
  - Giving prospective purchasers of the property notice of the absence of a policy of building indemnity insurance.

ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION ACT 1993  
SECTION 68

*Approval of Category B Containers*

I, Andrea Kaye Woods, Delegate of the Environment Protection Authority ('the Authority'), pursuant to Section 68 of the Environment Protection Act, 1993 (SA) ('the Act') hereby:

**Approval of Category B Containers:**

Approve as Category B Containers, subject to the conditions in subclauses 1, 2, 3 and 4 below, each of the classes of containers identified by reference to the following matters described in the first 4 columns of Schedule 1 of this Notice which are sold in South Australia:

- (a) the product which each class of containers shall contain;
  - (b) the size of the containers;
  - (c) the type of containers;
  - (d) the name of the holders of these approvals.
1. That containers of the class to which the approval relates must bear the refund marking specified by the Authority for containers of that class. The Authority specifies the following refund markings for Category B containers:
    - (1) "10c refund at collection depots when sold in SA", or
    - (2) "10c refund at SA/NT collection depots in State/Territory of purchase", or
    - (3) "10c refund at collection depots/points in participating state/territory of purchase"
  2. The holder of the approval must have in place an effective and appropriate waste management arrangement in relation to containers of that class. For the purpose of this approval notice the company named in column 5 of Schedule 1 of this Notice is the nominated super collector.
  3. In the case of an approval in relation to category B containers that the waste management arrangement must require the holder of the approval to provide specified super collectors with a declaration in the form determined by the Authority in relation to each sale of such containers by the holder of the approval as soon as practicable after the sale.
  4. The holder of these approvals must ensure that if a sticker bearing the refund marking has been approved, and is applied to the container, then the sticker must not be placed on any portion of the opening mechanism or in any other place that would require complete or partial removal of the sticker before the contents may be consumed.

## REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

REPORT NO. 3 OF 2019

*2019 Review of Salary of the Governor of South Australia*

### INTRODUCTION

1. The Remuneration Tribunal (“the Tribunal”) has jurisdiction under section 14 of the *Remuneration Act 1990* (“the Act”) and section 73 of the *Constitution Act 1934* (“the Constitution Act”), to determine the rate of salary payable to His Excellency the Governor of South Australia (“the Governor”).

### BACKGROUND

2. On 11 February 2016, the *Constitution (Governor’s Salary) Amendment Act 2015* (“the Amending Act”) came into operation, conferring jurisdiction upon the Tribunal to determine the rate of salary applicable to the office of the Governor. Prior to the commencement of the Amending Act, the rate of salary of the Governor was fixed by the Constitution Act at an amount equivalent to 75% of the salary of a puisne judge of the Supreme Court of South Australia.
3. In 2016, the Tribunal issued its inaugural Determination<sup>1</sup> of salary of the Governor, resulting in that salary being fixed at \$315,608 per annum, operative from 11 February 2016.

4. In 2017, the Tribunal conducted its annual review, resulting in the making of a Determination<sup>2</sup> which increased the level of salary of the Governor to \$323,183, operative from 1 January 2017.
  - <sup>2</sup> Remuneration Tribunal Determination 7 of 2017 – 2017 Review of Salary of the Governor of South Australia
5. In 2018, the Tribunal conducted its annual review, resulting in the making of a Determination<sup>3</sup> which fixed the rate of salary of the Governor of South Australia at an amount equivalent to 75% of the salary of a puisne judge of the Supreme Court of South Australia, until further Determination by the Tribunal.
  - <sup>3</sup> Remuneration Tribunal Determination 3 of 2018 – 2018 Review of Salary of the Governor of South Australia

### PROCEDURAL HISTORY

6. Section 10(2) of the Act provides that prior to the making of a Determination, the Tribunal must allow an affected person, or persons of an affected class, a reasonable opportunity to make submissions orally or in writing to the Tribunal.
7. Section 10(4) provides that the Minister responsible for the Act may intervene, personally or by counsel or other representative, in proceedings before the Tribunal for the purpose of introducing evidence, or making submissions, on any question relevant to the public interest.
8. The Tribunal, by letter dated 27 February 2019, invited the Governor to make a submission in relation to the review of the salary applicable to the office of the Governor.
9. The Tribunal, by letter dated 27 February 2019, invited the Honourable Premier of South Australia (“the Hon. Premier”), as the Minister responsible for the Act, to make submissions in the public interest.
10. In addition, on 4 March 2019, a notification of the review was placed on the Tribunal’s public website.

### SUBMISSIONS

11. The Official Secretary to the Governor wrote to the Tribunal, by letter dated 27 February 2019, advising that the Governor does not intend to make a submission in relation to the Tribunal’s review of the Governor’s salary in 2019.
12. The Crown Solicitor’s Office, on behalf of the Hon. Premier, notified the Tribunal on 13 March 2019 that the Hon. Premier does not wish to make a submission in relation to the determination of the Governor’s salary by the Tribunal in 2019.

### CONCLUSION

13. There is no basis that the Tribunal can discern which would lead to a variation of the terms of Determination 3 of 2018, which prescribes:
 

*“The Tribunal determines that the salary of the Governor of South Australia shall be an amount equal to seventy five per cent of the salary of a puisne judge of the Supreme Court of South Australia, until further Determination by the Tribunal.”*
14. The current salary of the Governor is \$344,130, operative from 1 January 2019. The effect of Determination 3 of 2018<sup>4</sup> is that the Governor’s salary will be adjusted from time to time, consequent on movements in the salary of a puisne judge of the Supreme Court.

15. Accordingly, the terms of Determination 3 of 2018 shall continue to apply.

## REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

REPORT NO. 4 OF 2019

*2019 Review of Remuneration for the Auditor-General, Electoral Commissioner,  
Deputy Electoral Commissioner and Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner*

**INTRODUCTION**

1. The Remuneration Tribunal (“the Tribunal”) has jurisdiction under section 14 of the *Remuneration Act 1990* (“the Act”) to determine the remuneration, or a specified part of remuneration, of certain statutory office holders, as conferred by other Acts or by proclamation by the Governor.
2. This Report concerns the remuneration of the following statutory office holders:
  - 2.1. the Auditor-General;
  - 2.2. the Electoral Commissioner;
  - 2.3. the Deputy Electoral Commissioner; and
  - 2.4. the Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner.

**BACKGROUND**

3. The last review of remuneration for the abovementioned statutory office holders was conducted in 2018, resulting in the Tribunal increasing the salaries of those office holders by 1.5 per cent, with an operative date of 1 January 2018.

**PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

4. Section 10(2) of the Act provides that prior to the making of a Determination, the Tribunal must allow an affected person, or persons of an affected class, a reasonable opportunity to make submissions orally or in writing to the Tribunal.
5. Section 10(4) provides that the Minister responsible for the Act may intervene, personally or by counsel or other representative, in proceedings before the Tribunal for the purpose of introducing evidence, or making submissions, on any question relevant to the public interest.
6. The Tribunal wrote to the statutory office holders listed at paragraph 2 of this Report on 27 February 2019, notifying of the Tribunal’s intention to conduct a review of remuneration for those offices.
7. On 27 February 2019, the Tribunal wrote to the Honourable Premier of South Australia (“the Hon. Premier”), as the Minister responsible for the Act, inviting submissions in the public interest.
8. In addition, on 4 March 2019, a notification of the review was placed on the Tribunal’s public website.

**SUBMISSIONS**

9. On 28 March 2019, the Tribunal received a submission on behalf of the Hon. Premier. That submission is summarised as follows:
  - 9.1. In relation to the 2019 review of salaries for Statutory Office Holders (specifically the Auditor-General, the Electoral Commissioner, the Deputy Electoral Commissioner and the Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner) and the Tribunal’s invitation by letter dated 27 February 2019, the Premier as the Minister responsible for the *Remuneration Act 1990* submits that the Tribunal have regard to the following factors:
    - the economic indicia outlined in the Premier’s submission; and
    - the movement in pay of executives in the public service operative from 1 July 2018.
  - 9.2. In relation to the 2019 review and consolidation of the Communication Allowance for Statutory Office Holders, the Premier submits that the Tribunal have regard to, and not significantly differ from, the following arrangements and practices:
    - the arrangements that apply in the public sector generally and in particular to public sector executives;
    - the provisions for telephone rental, call reimbursement and mobility services arrangements that apply to employees in the public sector generally and in particular to public sector executives.
10. No other submissions were received by the Tribunal in respect of this Review.

**CONSIDERATION**

11. The Tribunal has had regard to the economic background against which the review was conducted. That consideration includes the information referred to in the Premier’s submission.
12. The Tribunal identified the following considerations:
  - 12.1. The Reserve Bank of Australia (“RBA”) economic outlook for inflation of 1.75% for the year ending December 2019;
  - 12.2. A movement in the Australian Bureau of Statistics (“ABS”) Consumer Price Index for Adelaide of 1.3% for the year ending March 2019;
  - 12.3. The Wage Price Index for Public Sector employment, as published by the Australian Bureau of Statistics, was 2.5% for South Australia and 2.5% for Australia, for the year ending December 2018.
  - 12.4. The state of the South Australian Economy as described in the Treasurer’s budget papers of 2018, as follows;

**“Economic outlook**

*The economic challenges arising from the cessation of car manufacturing in South Australia have been relatively well accommodated, with continuing overall employment growth and a fall in the unemployment rate. The declines in production and employment in the manufacturing industry have been offset by growth in service based industries, led by health care and social assistance.*

*Employment in South Australia is likely to continue to be supported by public sector investment in transport projects, by private sector investment (including OZ Minerals’ Carrapateena project and Senvion’s Ceres wind farm project). In the medium term, naval shipbuilding projects (future frigates and submarines) offer the potential for significant job opportunities, including in supply chain firms.*

*Although retail spending growth has seen gradual declines from its recent peak in late 2014, it is likely that recent strong employment growth, continued sources of inexpensive consumer credit and growing tourist numbers will be supportive of household spending going forward. A number of surveys have confirmed strong business confidence in South Australia in recent months. This bodes well for growth in the state.*

Forecasts and projections for South Australia from 2018–19 onwards take into consideration the expected performance of the international, national and state economies over the medium term. Forecasts and projections also depend on key assumptions around population growth rates and the relative performance of the state's economic sectors. Taking into consideration the relevant information on the past trends of the South Australia economy and having allowed for sensitivities in key assumptions, South Australia's GSP is forecast to increase by 2¼ per cent in real terms in 2018–19, following similar growth in 2017–18. South Australian employment is forecast to grow by 1½ per cent in 2018–19, revised up from 1 per cent in the mid-year budget review. South Australia's SFD is forecast to grow by 2½ per cent in 2018–19, revised up from 2¼ per cent since the mid-year budget review as a result of stronger than expected economic conditions."

- 12.5. Monetary Policy decision of the Reserve Bank of Australia, dated 2 April 2019, Statement by Governor Philip Lowe of the RBA:

"Inflation remains low and stable. Underlying inflation is expected to pick up gradually over the next couple of years, although this has been taking a little longer than earlier expected. The central scenario is for underlying inflation to be 2 per cent this year and 2¼ per cent in 2020. In the near term, headline inflation is expected to decline because of lower petrol prices earlier in the year, while underlying inflation is expected to remain broadly stable."

"The Australian labour market remains strong. There has been a significant increase in employment and the unemployment rate is at 4.9 per cent. The vacancy rate remains high and there are reports of skills shortages in some areas. The stronger labour market has led to some pick-up in wages growth, which is a welcome development. Continued improvement in the labour market is expected to see some further lift in wages growth over time, although this is still expected to be a gradual process."

- 12.6. The media statement<sup>1</sup> of Minister Pisoni on 18 April 2019, as follows:

"The latest jobs figures showed encouraging signs of employment growth, with a record 848,300 South Australians employed in trend terms."

- 12.7. The Tribunal also considered movements in public sector remuneration. The *South Australian Modern Public Sector Enterprise Agreement: Salaried 2017* provides for weighted average salary increases of 2.3% in 2018 and 2.3% in 2019.

- 12.8. The following table illustrates historical increases for the statutory office holders to whom this Report relates and those employees covered by the *South Australian Modern Public Sector Enterprise Agreement: Salaried 2017*:

- 12.9. The Tribunal also had consideration to movements in public sector executive salaries in 2018. Those salaries were adjusted by 1.5% with an operative date of 1 July 2018. The increase to Public Sector Executive salaries, if any, by Cabinet in respect of executive salaries in 2019 is yet to be determined. The Tribunal anticipates that the level of salary prescribed by the accompanying Determination will operate for the whole of 2019.

- 12.10. The following table illustrates historical increases for the statutory office holders to whom this Report relates compared with public sector executives:

## CONCLUSION

13. The Tribunal considered it was appropriate to balance all of the above considerations in order to come to a fair outcome for the statutory office holders whose remuneration will be subject the Determination to which this Report relates.
14. The Tribunal has decided to increase the salaries of the statutory office holders at paragraph 2 of this report by 2% per cent.
15. The accompanying Determination 4 of 2019 will issue accordingly.

## COMMUNICATION ALLOWANCE

16. The Tribunal has reviewed its Determination in relation to statutory office holders Communication Allowance<sup>2</sup>. The Tribunal has had regard to the relevant statistical measure which comprises the basis of consideration of the Communications Allowance for the statutory office holders to whom the accompanying Determination applies. The Tribunal has decided to make no adjustment to the level of the Communication Allowance accordingly.

**SCOPE OF DETERMINATION**

1. The Remuneration Tribunal ("the Tribunal") has jurisdiction under section 14 of the *Remuneration Act 1990* ("the Act") to determine the remuneration, or a specified part of remuneration, of certain statutory office holders, as conferred by other Acts or by proclamation by the Governor.
2. This Determination applies to the following statutory office holders:
  - 2.1 the Auditor-General;
  - 2.2 the Electoral Commissioner;
  - 2.3 the Deputy Electoral Commissioner; and
  - 2.4 the Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner.

**SALARY**

3. The Tribunal hereby determines the following salaries shall be payable in respect of the following statutory offices:

The rate of salary applicable to the office of Auditor-General shall be \$330,312 per annum.
  - 3.2 **Electoral Commissioner**  
The rate of salary applicable to the office of Electoral Commissioner shall be \$235,013 per annum.
  - 3.3 **Deputy Electoral Commissioner**  
The rate of salary applicable to the office of Deputy Electoral Commissioner shall be \$176,001 per annum.  
When acting as Electoral Commissioner for a continuous period of more than one week, the Deputy Electoral Commissioner shall be paid for the acting period at the rate of salary applicable to the office of Electoral Commissioner.
  - 3.4 **Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner**  
The rate of salary applicable to the office of Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner shall be \$243,420 per annum.

**COMMUNICATION ALLOWANCE**

4. Each of the statutory office holders listed at clause 2 of this Determination shall be entitled to be paid a communication allowance at the rate of \$800 per annum, for expenditures for the purpose of mobile telephone, landline telephone and internet usage incurred in relation to the conduct of their official duties.
5. The allowance is payable fortnightly and at a fortnightly rate of the annual amount payable at clause 4 of this Determination.
6. Where a statutory office holder listed at clause 2 of this Determination is appointed on a part-time basis, that person is entitled to be paid a communications allowance as a pro rata amount of the communication allowance prescribed at clause 4 of this Determination, based on the hours worked as a proportion of the full-time equivalent.
7. The Determination of communication allowance at clauses 4, 5 and 6 of this Determination supersedes any previous Determinations in relation to communication allowance for the statutory office holders to whom this Determination applies.

**ACCOMMODATION AND MEAL ALLOWANCES**

8. Accommodation and Meal Allowances pursuant to the Tribunal's Determination 14 of 2018 continue to apply, as amended from time to time.

**CONVEYANCE ALLOWANCE**

9. Conveyance Allowances pursuant to the Tribunal's Determination 15 of 2018 continue to apply, as amended from time to time.
