#### **Part 1—Preliminary**

##### **1—Short title**

These regulations may be cited as the *Emergency Management (Expiation Notices) Variation Regulations 2020*.

##### **2—Commencement**

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

##### **3—Variation provisions**

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

#### **Part 2—Variation of *Emergency Management Regulations 2009***

##### **4—Insertion of regulation 6**

After regulation 5 insert:

##### **6—Authorised officers may give expiation notices**

- (1) Subject to the *Expiation of Offences Act 1996*, an authorised officer is authorised to give expiation notices for alleged offences against section 28 of the Act.

- (2) The expiation fee for an offence against section 28 of the Act is fixed at—
- (a) in the case of a natural person—\$1 000; or
  - (b) in the case of a body corporate—\$5 000.

**Note—**

As required by section 10AA(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978*, the Minister has certified that, in the Minister's opinion, it is necessary or appropriate that these regulations come into operation as set out in these regulations.
