# Part 1—Preliminary

#### 1—Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Emergency Management (Expiation Notices) Variation Regulations 2020.* 

## 2—Commencement

These regulations come into operation on the day on which they are made.

#### 3—Variation provisions

In these regulations, a provision under a heading referring to the variation of specified regulations varies the regulations so specified.

# Part 2—Variation of Emergency Management Regulations 2009

#### 4—Insertion of regulation 6

After regulation 5 insert:

#### 6—Authorised officers may give expiation notices

(1) Subject to the *Expiation of Offences Act 1996*, an authorised officer is authorised to give expiation notices for alleged offences against section 28 of the Act.

- (2) The expiation fee for an offence against section 28 of the Act is fixed at—
  - (a) in the case of a natural person—\$1 000; or
  - (b) in the case of a body corporate—\$5 000.

#### Note—

As required by section 10AA(2) of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1978*, the Minister has certified that, in the Minister's opinion, it is necessary or appropriate that these regulations come into operation as set out in these regulations.
